# Westmont has fun, Co-Ed track title, too

It is supposed to be a fun-filled day of track and field, and that is exactly the sort of day Westmont enjoyed Saturday in winning the Saratoga Co-Ed Relays at Los Gatos.

The unusual meet, begun last year by Saratoga coach George Wightman, brings together relay teams composed of two boys and two girls. Westmont won just two events — the 2½-mile cross country race and the high jump — but finished second in three others to total 57 points, 15 more than second-place Los Gatos. Fremont was third with 35 and Saratoga had 34.

As expected, a flock of meet records were broken — six, to be exact. Leigh's four-mile relay was particularly impressive, running a 20:24.4 to better last year's mark by almost 18 seconds.

Del Mar's Marcus Bass defended his triple jump title, although he couldn't equal last year's mark of 47-0¾ (he was six inches short). And the pole vault competition, which lasted long after most of the fans had left, was tough, with Warren Jaques of Del Mar finally earning the title on the basis of fewer misses. He cleared 14-8.
