# "THE CIF STORY"

California's State High School Track and Field Championship Meet is recognized as THE most outstanding interscholastic track event in the United States. The meet also signifies the leadership of the California Interscholastic Federation in fostering sportsmanlike competition among public and private schools throughout the state.

Formed in 1914, the State Federation's general purpose has been to serve as the agency through which member high schools may cooperatively adopt rules and regulations under which the schools could conduct their interscholastic athletic programs.

The 1979 State CIF Championship Track and Field Meet will be the 61st state championship for boys and the 5th state championship for girls competition. Track and field competition in the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section, and in the Sacramento area particularly, is well established. Sacramento area athletes are always among the top challengers for the individual championships.

The quality of performances in the State Track Meet are perhaps best attested by comparing the State CIF Track Meet Championship record with the national record in each of the events. Both the state and national records are listed in the program on each of the event pages. Many of the national records are held by California high school students.

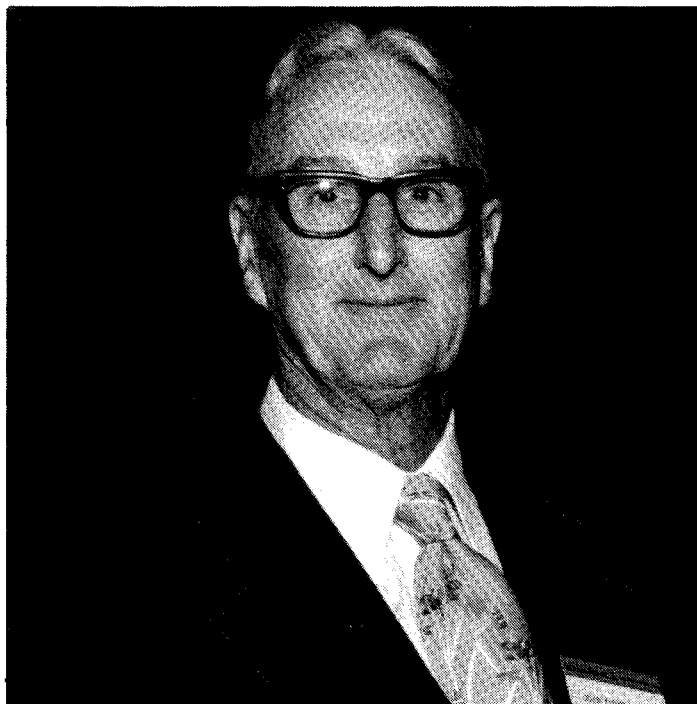

Since 1970 he has served as a member of the statewide governing board of the California Interscholastic Federation, representing the California State Department of Education in his capacity of State Director of Physical Education, Athletics and Recreation. John's service with the California State Department of Education spans a period of 20 years. John was an outstanding athlete in high school and college. He was chosen on the All-Pacific Coast Conference Football Team as an end when he played for Washington State University.

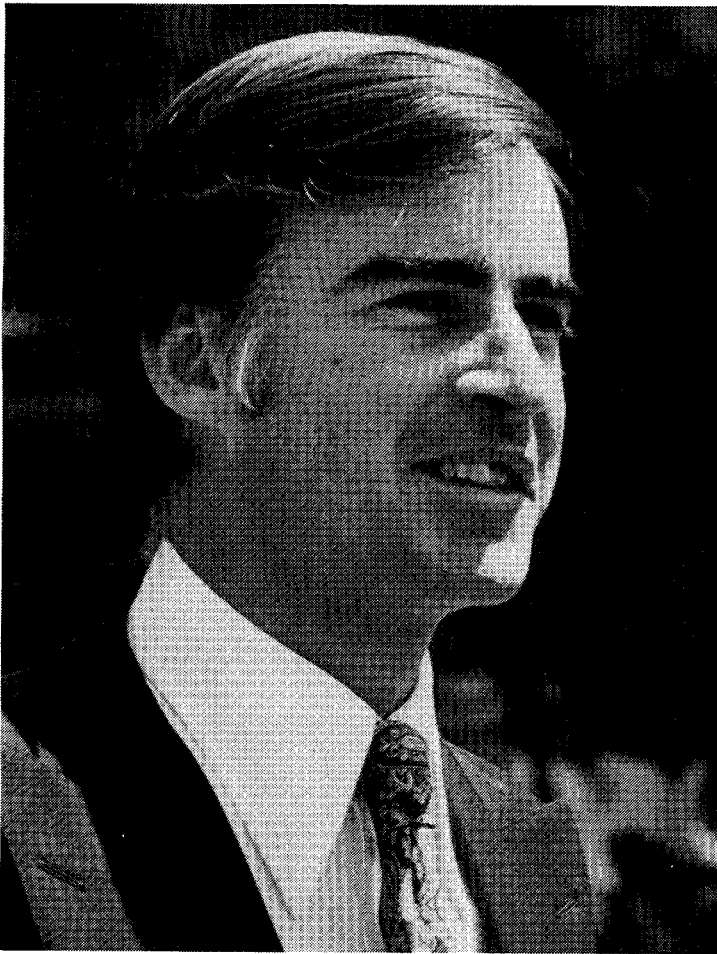
As a member of the State CIF Federated Council and as a representative of the State Department of Education, John Klumb has provided assistance and interpretation to California's schools regarding equal opportunity for the sexes in education and athletics. 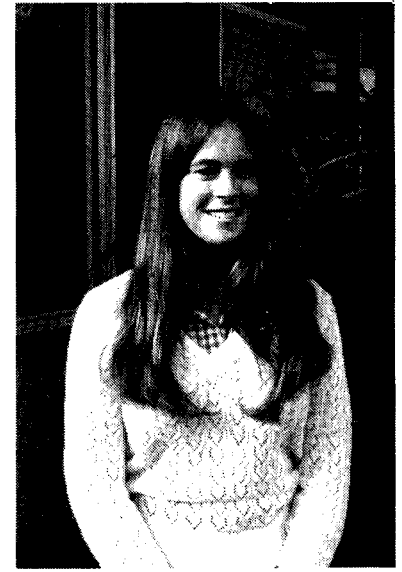


Al Hooker

One of the co-directors of this year's state meet is Al Hooker. For twelve years he served as track coach at La Sierra High School. During that time he directed three Sac-Joaquin section championship meets, several sub-section meets and twice the Golden West Invitational.

Hooker's teams compiled a dual meet record 87 wins, 22 losses and 1 tie. His teams captured 6 league championships, many invitational titles and sent 26 athletes to the state meet.

Hooker is particularly excited about the return of the state meet to Sacramento after an absence of 29 years. With the great number of defending champions this years' meet should rank among the best ever.



Lindy Jack

Lindy Jack will be the first woman to serve in the capacity of co-meet director. While several women have helped administer the meet in the past, Lindy is the first to assume the top position.

Jack was selected as female track coach of the year in 1978 by Cal Coachs Assn. In three seasons as coach at Cordova High School her teams were undefeated in dual meet competition winning the metro league championship all three years.

# CIF Boys' Honorary Coaches



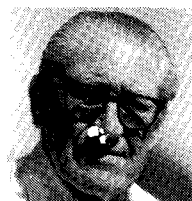

Every year the girls' program has improved, and it should continue to improve with the increased interest and enthusiasm at Casa Roble. Ernie says the outstanding record has been due to a group of talented, cooperative and fantastic individuals.



**Bob McGuire**, Pleasant Hill High School, has been a major contributor to track and field in the North Coast Section for over 20 years. During Ms. Miller's tenure as track coach at Trinity, her teams were consistently competitive.



**Joyce Murray**, of Hanford High School of the Central Section, coached for 19 years. She was the coach of Hanford High School track team fro 1965-74. Track and Field World rated her Hanford Team #1 in the nation for three consecutive years. Her teams won League and Valley championships for eight straight years. Her team also won the Junior West Coast Relays. Joyce started the first girls' cross country team in the valley in 1966 and traveled all over the state for competition. Joyce helped organize the Tri-County League and was instrumental in getting girls' track and field accepted into Central Section CIF as a recognized CIF sport. For the past four years, she has served numerous times as meet referee. Joyce currently serves on the CIF Central Section League Placement Committee.



**Gail Balsley**, Central Section, graduated from Washington State in 1966. Gail has been teaching for twelve years with the last eight years at Camden High School in San Jose. The girls' varsity team remains undefeated in dual competition for the past three years, while the girls' junior varsity team has never been defeated in dual competition.

Marge is a member of the Southern California Track Starters' Association. So, when her coaching days are over, you probably will still hear her calling runners "on your mark" as a track starter.



**Virginia Huddleston**, Los Angeles Section, Carson High School. Virginia graduated from Occidental College i 1944 and has been teaching and coaching in the Los Angeles City Schools for 35 years. 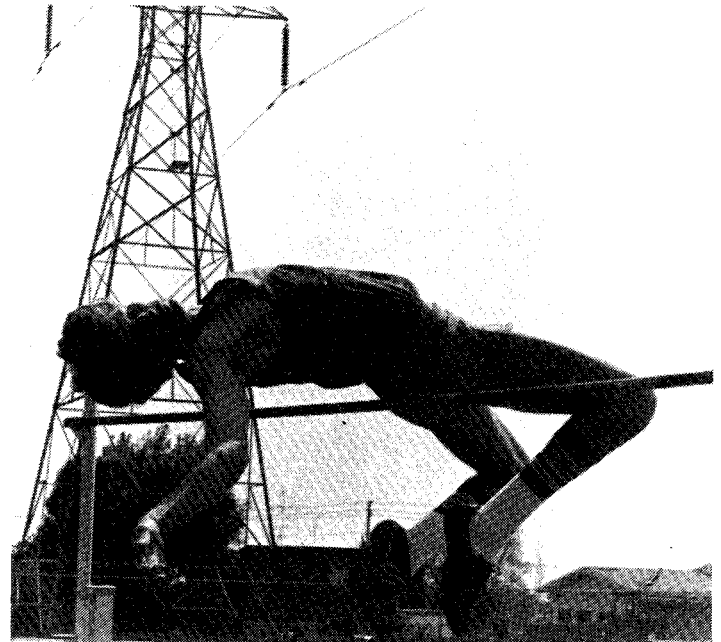
