#### **CADET ATHLETICS**

Not all athletes become Air Force Academy cadets, but all Air Force Academy cadets become athletes. Few schools in the country have as broad or as extensive an athletic program as the Air Force Academy.

The goal of the athletic program is to develop such traits as persistence, will to win, aggressiveness and courage – all characteristics of a good leader. The Academy curriculum is divided into three main areas – academics, military training and athletics. A cadet must excel in all three areas to earn his or her second lieutenant commission and bachelor of science degree.

Under the guidance of Athletic Director Col. John Clune, the athletic program is broken down into three subdivisions: intercollegiate, intramural and physical education.

Eighteen intercollegiate men's and ten women's sports compete at the Air Force Academy. Varsity men's teams face some of the top teams in the nation in football, cross country, soccer, water polo, basketball, fencing, rifle, pistol, ice hockey, gymnastics, indoor track, wrestling, swimming, baseball, outdoor track, lacrosse, golf and tennis. Currently, women's teams are fielded in cross country, volleyball, basketball, gymnastics, fencing, swimming, indoor and outdoor track, golf and tennis. Women also compete in pistol and rifle.


The intramural program is conducted by cadets under the supervision of the physical education department. Each cadet squadron fields a team in each of 17 sports – tackle football, soccer, tennis, flickerball, boxing, wrestling, water polo, handball, squash, rugby, basketball, swimming, cross country, team handball, volleyball, flag football, and racquetball.

Air Force will enter Western Athletic Conference competition effective July 1, 1980, with competition in 10 sports: baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, swimming, tennis, indoor track, outdoor track and wrestling. Other sports such as soccer, lacrosse, women's volleyball and women's basketball also compete in leagues.

Cadet athletes enjoy the best facilities available anywhere. The Cadet Gymnasium contains 24 squashball courts; 19 handball courts; six basketball courts which have cross court floors; two swimming pool areas; an indoor rifle and pistol range; gymnastics, wrestling, fencing and boxing rooms; a supply area; several training rooms and lockets for all cadets and coaches offices.

The \$5.6 million field house contains a one-sixth mile indoor track with an Astro-Turf infield, a basketball court with Tartan floor for varsity competition, a regulation ice hockey rink, training rooms, lockers for cadets and the officers of the athletic department, and administrative offices of the athletic department.

Able to accomodate over 46,000 spectators, Falcon Stadium is the site of varsity football contests with such nationally ranked foes as Notre Dame, Army and Navy. Other outdoor facilities include 45 athletic fields covering 143 acres for intercollegiate and intramural sports, two baseball diamonds and a 400-meter all-weather track. Also Eisenhower Golf Course, located on the Academy, offers two 18hole courses for varsity golf and cross country competition.

# MAJOR ERNIE CUNLIFFE HEAD COACH

Starting his second year as men's track coach is Maj. Ernie Cunliffe, who has been coach of the Air Force world-wide team for the last seven years.

Major Cunliffe also serves as the women's cross country coach and guided the Falcons to the AIAW Division II Championships last Fall.

A native of Claremont, Calif., Cunliffe was an outstanding middle distance runner at Stanford, representing the U.S. in the 1960 Olympics in Rome in the 800 meters, placing third in the 1963 Pan American Games and fifth in the 1959 Pan American Games. The holder of three world records, he was twice national champion and five times an All-American in track and field. He graduated from Stanford in 1960 with a bachelor of arts degree in education, receiving a master of arts degree in education a year later from the same school. He entered the Air Force in 1961 and in 1963 was assigned to the ROTC detachment at the University of Oregon, earning a master of science degree in recreation in 1966 and adding a doctor of education degree in higher education from Oregon in 1969.

He then moved to the Air Force Academy in 1969 and served in the registrar's office for four years before moving to Lackland AFB, Tex., where he picked up the coaching duties with the Air Force world-wide team. He has represented the U.S. on nine international teams as a competitor and has been chief of mission, head coach or manager on eight other national teams.

In recognition of his extensive international track background as a competitor and coach, Cunliffe was recently selected to be an assistant manager for the 1980 U.S. Olympic track team that will compete in Moscow.

# CAPTAIN DICK LEGAS Head Junior Varsity Coach

One of the top javelin throwers in the nation with a career best of 264 feet, Capt. Dick Legas is in his second year as head junior varsity coach after serving as an assistant coach in 1977.

A native of Ogden, Utah, Legas was an outstanding javelin thrower and decathlon athlete at Brigham Young University, graduating from there in 1971. While at BYU, he was the track team captain and placed in the javelin in both the 1966 and 1969 national collegiate championship meets. He has also represented the U.S. on several international teams.

His previous Air Force assignments include Lackland AFB, Tex.; Williams AFB, Ariz.; and Webb AFB, Tex.



# CAPTAIN RICH COTE Assistant Varsity Coach

Returning to the Falcon track coaching staff this year after a two-year educational leave is Capt. Rich Cote, who in his third season as an assistant varsity coach.

Cote first started with the Falcon track program in 1967 as a varsity hurdler, setting a Cadet Field House record in the 60-yard low hurdles. In his first two years on the Falcon staff, he helped coach a national record-setting shuttle hurdles relay team and an All-American 440-yard relay team.

A 1971 graduate of the Academy, Cote earned his master of arts degree in exercise physiology from Ball State and his Ph.D. in the same field from the University of Arizona.

# CAPTAIN JIM SCOTT Assistant Varsity Coach

A veteran member of the Air Force Academy track program, Capt. Jim Scott is now in his second season as an assistant varsity coach.

He started with the Falcon program in 1975 and in 1976 guided the junior varsity team to a record of 11-5-1, both indoors and outdoors. During the 1977-78 school year, he was the women's head cross country coach.

A native of Altus, Okla., Scott is a 1971 graduate of the University of South Carolina, where he was an outstanding pole vaulter. Prior to being assigned to the Academy in 1973, he was stationed at McGuire AFB, N.J., for two years.

He earned his master of arts degree in exercise physiology from the University of California-Santa Barbara in 1977.

#### CADET TRACKS AMONG NATION'S FASTEST

Two of the fastest tracks in the nation are located at the Air Force Academy.

The indoor track in the Cadet Field House is a 293yard, six-laps-to-the-mile Tartan surface that surrounds an Astroturf infield. The outdoor track is a 400-meter all-weather surface installed in 1978 by Advanced Coatings Inc. of Buena Park, Calif.

Both tracks have produced some of the top marks in the world in recent years. The indoor track was first used during the 1969 indoor season while the outdoor track produced outstanding performances during the first two National Sports Festivals held at the Academy in 1978 and 1979.

The indoor track is located inside one of the most impressive sports buildings in the nation -- the Cadet Field House.

A modern versatile structure with seemingly endless uses, the field house was built at a cost of \$5.6 million, is five stories high and measures 396 feet by 425 feet, the size of three football fields laid side by side.

The structure is actually three buildings in one -- a basketball arena, an ice hockey arena and a massive multipurpose area that includes a netted area 119 feet by 125 feet for use by baseball for batting and infiel<sup>4</sup> practice.

The multipurpose area also contains a long jump and triple jump pit, a high jump pit, a pole vault pit and a shot put area for indoor meets.

The indoor track area can seat up to 1,000 people while the outdoor track can accommodate up to 15,000 by using the grassy banks on the west side of the track. In 1971, a crowd of 14,000 was at the outdoor track to watch the final day of the National AAU Junior Olympics competition.
