HAYWARD

Talent in both running and field events should enable Cal State Hayward Women's Track team to be a powerhouse in 1980. The Pioneers enjoyed tremendous success in the 70's producing 15 AIAW All American honorees and 2 AIAW All American relay teams, a place in the top 20 of AIAW National Championship six times; 2nd-1971, 1st-1972, 3rd-1973, 12th-1977, 10th-1978 and 20th-1979; and they have won the Golden State Conference Championship the past three years.

CAL STATE

Cal State returns six performers from last year's team, in addition to an excellent nucleus of newcomers.

Senior sprinters Yvonne Boone 100 HH and 400 HH GSC Champion (14.2 and 63.2) and Vicki Booker 100 and 200 M (11.9 and 25.6) will team with newcomers freshmen Dawn Peters, Northgate High (100y-10.8, 220y-24.9), Cynthis Davis Villa Park High (100-11.9) and Kelly Hamilton Alameda High. Glenna Pickel, a fine sprinter and hurdler the past two years for Cal State, returns for another campaign.

Quarter-milers Collen Moran Santa Barbara JC (56.5) Debbie Zwick Foothill College (57.3) and freshman Tricia Kinman Moreau High (400 yd (60.0) appear to be ready for a fine season.

The Pioneer middle distance corps shape up to be a big plus on this year's club Mary Rieboldt, former half-miler and current school record holder in the 1,500 (4:45.1) will be pressed by Frannie Castro, Hancock College, 3rd in the state JC In the weight events Cal State will have more depth than in years past. Elaine Sundby from Foothill College with a best in the javelin (146) and discus (120) placed 2nd in the 1979 California JC javelin finals.

Roxanne Kasparian from Fresno JC with a PR of 39-8, shot put; and 140-0 discus; Beth Lyster Diable Valley College, Shot Put and Discus (39-0, 115-0); Marla Rosenblat Hancock College with a PR of 126 in the javelin; freshman Linda Read Alameda High second in both shot put and discus during California High School Track and Field Championships in 1978-79 with throws of 152-0 and 42-6, will give the Pioneers valuable points in meets this season.

The jumping events feature Dawn Peters LJ (18-9), Cynthia Davis LJ (18-4) and high jump (5-2), Debbie Zwick long jump (17-1) and Tricia Kinman high jump (5-4).

Bob McGuire who begins his 3rd year as coach of the Pioneers, anticipates a good season. "We lose some key performers from last season," McGuire said, "but the talent and depth on this season's squad could make this the best team ever at Hayward."
