# Tully & Bell Attack World Record

Walnut, Ca., April 19-20 /from Scott Davis/—"It was World Record weather," said Mike Tully after outduelling Earl Bell at the Mt. SAC Relays.

The former UCLA star won the high-flying vault competition thanks to his first-time clearance of 18-4¼, compared to Bell's third-effort clearance. Three others topped 18-½. Tully and Bell each took shots at 5.71 (18-8¾)—a height, as Mal Florence of the *Los Angeles Times* pointedly observed, Tully had cleared before.

That was his ill-fated "World Record" in 1978 which was not accepted as it was never remeasured since the bar was knocked off the pegs by officials.

Here, Tully's 2nd and 3rd shots at that ceiling were both in the category of sooooo close. He barely brushed off the bar each time and the agony showed on his face as he fell into the pit with both fists clenched.

"I felt great during the jumping," Tully commented, "and the conditions were perfect for attempting the Record. I was happy to jump well today because I'm geared to jumping well in June and July."

Bell, who came closest to clearing 5.71 on his final effort, said, "I feel like I've been through a tough workout. I'm really tired; I feel like I can't get my breath."

The smoggy weather wasn't the most conducive to healthful conditions: the Pollutant Standard Index is Good=0-100, Unhealthful=100-200, Very Unhealthful=200-300, Hazardous=300-500. The local reading was 205 on Saturday.

But the smog didn't prevent more than 6000 athletes from competing in 320 events over a span of 5 days.

Deby LaPlante—who says, "I'm recovering from all my injuries but I'm doing it slowly"—sped 13.16 over the 100 hurdles, the year's fastest, to best another veteran who is coming back from injuries, Patty van Wolvelaere.

Young Dolly Fleetwood traded strides with Lisa Hopkins for virtually the entire 100 meters before edging ahead at the wire for an 11.30 victory. Hopkins duplicated that time as both claim a share of 8th on the all-time U.S. list.

James King ran the year's fastest set of intermediates with 49.24. Andre Phillips was off fast and led for 3 hurdles and shared the lead with Sam Turner until the 7th barrier. As he did at the Jenner meet, King then turned it on into the homestretch to take command for good as Turner faded.

Ageless Al Oerter spun the discus 214-3 on his opening throw and it held up against a superb field. Mac Wilkins came closest with 213-4 in round 5.

Dave McKenzie (see p. 57) reached a

hammer PR of 230-4, while John McArdle extended his best to 225-0. In the shot, Steve Summers pumped his 5th heave out to 68-1½ to eventually best top-rated American Dave Laut. Both Summers and McArdle claim 12th among all-time U.S. throwers.

Elsewhere among the hundreds of contests held on the track, Jan Merrill turned in a nice 1500/10,000 double. She was trying for the 10,000 AR but ran only 35:02.7 before returning later in the day for a 4:13.54 win in the 1500.

In the men's 400, Charles Oliver sped a PR 45.41 with UCLA freshman Tony Banks in hot pursuit the entire distance. Banks also notched a PR in 2nd, 45.82, and then contributed a 45.6 2nd leg on the 3:04.9 4 x 400 winners.

The 800 was a circus with 17 two-lappers in the race. Johnnie Gray led the hoard with a 51.8 first lap, while Mike Boit saved his move until the middle of the final turn. Young Billy Konchellah of Kenya was about 15m behind when Boit took off, but got his long legs going and moved into 2nd with 75m remaining.

Konchellah closed fast, but the experienced Boit held him off by exactly 0.6, 1:46.19 to 1:46.79.

In the decathlon, Fred Dixon showed

he is recovered from his injuries as he tallied 8088 hand-timed points. Ten men bettered 7500 points and the 10th, Nevada vaulter Lane Maestretti, picked up a passel of points (1113, to be exact) with a U.S. decathlon record of 17-3.

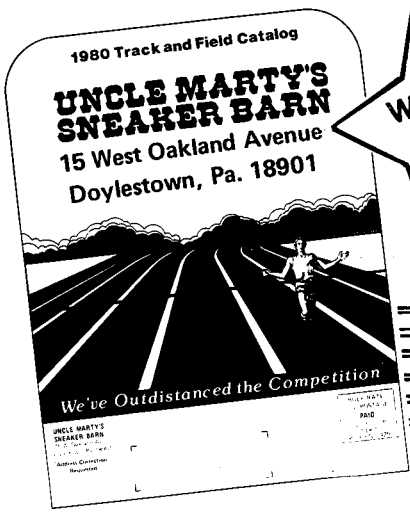

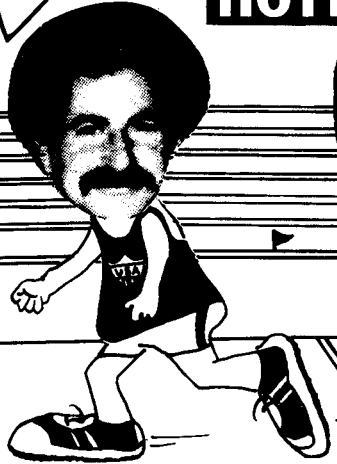
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
