# THE OLYMPIC GAMES

The 1980 Olympics are just around the corner!

There will be an added excitement in the air this spring as athletes around the world strive for the mark that will qualify them for 1980's Moscow-bound squad. San Diego State will be generating a good deal of that excitement as a handful of Aztec hopefuls will be giving it their best shot as the July deadline draws near.

Leading the way for SDSU Olympic contenders will be 200 meter ace David Russell. Russell, a 1979 All-American who finished 6th nationally, has already met the 1980 standard and can now set his sights on some gold.

Pole vault specialist Bill Halverson is only inches away from qualifying. After a WAC indoor title in 1979 and finishing fifth nationally, Halverson's spot on the American team looks promising.

Sophomore sprinter Ed Daniels will be making a strong bid for the Games as he has only to equal previous performances during the qualifying period to earn a place with this year's U.S. track representatives. Daniels, at one time last year, owned the fastest time in the world for the 400 meters with a 45.6 clocking.

Other Aztec Olympian prospects include Greg Simons, currently the Bermuda record holder at 400 meters, and Britain's national champion in the discus, Richard Slaney.

Rounding out the crew of medal-minded Aztecs are sprinter Brad MacDonald and high jumper Frank Shiefer. Like Daniels, MacDonald and Shiefer need only match their personal highs this spring in order to qualify.



## QUALIFYING STANDARDS

Performances must be accomplished under the conditions required for the recognition of National Records. The period during which entry standards must have been achieved will be 31st MAY 1979 to 6th JULY 1980. The closing date for the receipt of individual entries by the Moscow Olympic Organizing Committee will be the 13th JULY 1980.

## Head Coach Dick Hill

Entering his seventh year as head track mentor at San Diego State, few coaches have compiled credentials as impressive as those of Dick Hill. In addition to his fine college coaching background, Hill has also enjoyed a great deal of professional success in coaching athletes to 30 world records, three individual gold medals, and numerous American, NCAA and NAIA records.

Hill came to San Diego State in 1973 from Southern University, where he coached from 1965 to 1969 and in 1971 and 1972. A 1960 alumnus of Southern with a B.S. in physical education, his teams there won five NAIA national titles in three years, and Hill was named National Track Coach of the Year. At one point his teams owned or tied every outdoor world record in the mile relay, had sole possession of the 440 relay, and were national champs and record holders in the 880 and sprint-medley relays. His Southern team was deemed "the most outstanding team of the decade" (1960-70) by *Track & Field News*.

Southern won NAIA championships outdoors in 1966, 1967, and 1968, as well as the 1966 and 1967 indoor titles. After a year's leave of absence in 1970 to complete his Ed.D (doctoral) degree at the State University of New York (Buffalo), Hill returned to Southern and in 1972, a five-man team placed fifth at the NAIA Nationals.

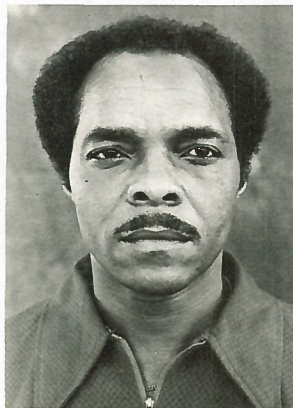
Hill began his collegiate coaching career at Florida A&M University, where he was head track coach and head basketball coach from 1962 to 1964.

Hill has had great success coaching individual athletes. At Florida A&M, he coached Bob Hayes to world records at 100-yards and 100-meters, as well as the 1964 Olympic gold medal. At Southern, Hill coached high hurdlers Willie Davenport, the 1968 Olympic champion, and Rod Milburn, who won the 1972 Olympic gold medal. Both athletes tied and broke numerous indoor and outdoor records in the hurdles. Also at Southern, members of his teams broke the world records in the 440-yard, 880-yard, and mile relays. For two years at San Diego State, he coached Steve Williams, who tied both the 100-yard and 100-meter world records.

In 1975, Hill was a coach with the first team in history to compete against the Peoples Republic of China in Canton, Shanghai, and Peking. Among recent endeavors, Hill spent two weeks in West Africa early in 1979 conducting a continental track course for Olympic coaches. He has also been named team manager for the West Team in the Colorado Sports Festival and is the national high hurdles chairman for the Olympic Development Committee in Colorado Springs.

Hill's 1979 edition of Aztec Track and Field finished 4-1 in dual action, and went on to a strong second place finish in its first year of Western Athletic Conference competition. In last year's NCAA Championships, San Diego State showed well enough to notch 6 points and a tie for 31st.

Highlights for the year included a first time ever victory over Long Beach State, by better than 40 points. The Aztecs also downed PCAA Champ UC Irvine in both their confrontations.



## Fred LaPlante Assistant Track Coach

Fred LaPlante, who currently is head coach for the Aztecs' Men and Women's Cross Country Teams, joins Hill's staff as the distance expert.

A native of Toledo, Ohio, LaPlante received his B.S. from Eastern Michigan in Physical Education and English in 1972. He went on to attain a Master's Degree in Physical Education from the same school.

Before coming to San Diego State, the 29-year-old LaPlante was an assistant men's track coach at Columbia University (New York, N.Y.). LaPlante's other coaching credentials include head track coach for men and women at Garden City East High School in Garden City, Mich.; men's head cross country coach at Washenaw Community College in Ann Arbor, Mich.; men's head track coach at Hoover Junior High School in Taylor, Mich.; and graduate assistant track coach at Eastern Michigan.

As a competitor, LaPlante was a NCAA-College Division All-American in the 1500 meters and was a member of two NCAA-CD National Championship teams.

LaPlante is presently the Western Collegiate Athletic Association cross country coordinator, a member of the Region 8 Cross Country Committee, and director for the Kinney Shoes National High School Invitational.



## Joe Briski Assistant Track Coach

Joe Briski enters his second year as an Aztec assistant after joining the staff in 1979.

Briski, who was the San Diego State track team captain in 1978, will be working in an area that was his specialty in college, the field events.

A 1978 Aztec graduate, the 24-year-old Briski majored in both journalism and history. He is the PCAA Meet record holder in the hammer throw and won the PCAA championships in 1977 and 1978 in that event. He also holds the SDSU record in the hammer throw at 195-3.

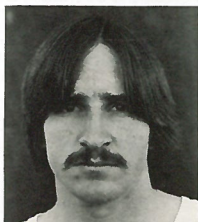

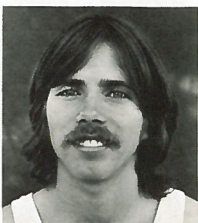

**ROBERT COULSON** . . . Distances . . . 5-8 . . . 137 . . . Senior



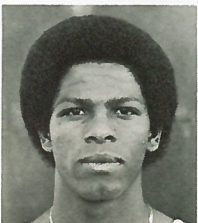

**DON COULTER** . . . 440/220 . . . 6-0 . . . 185 . . . Junior



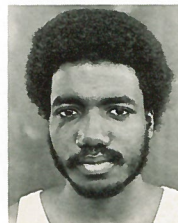

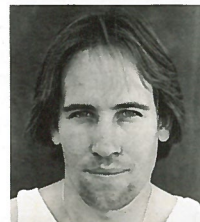

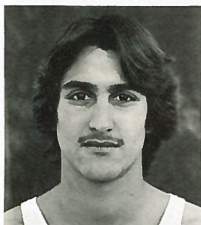

**CRAIG MONTGOMERY . . T-Jump . . 5-11 . . 150 . . Soph**



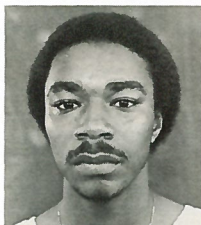

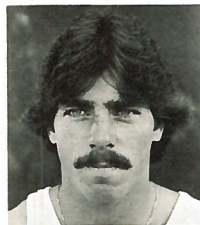

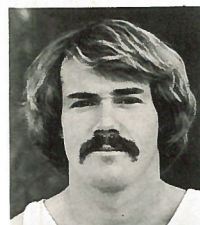
