

# Women's meet draws top field

Many of the top female track and field performers in Northern California will compete in the Stanford Women's Classic in Stanford Stadium at 1 o'clock this afternoon.

Stanford and Cal have entered full teams, and Stanislaus State and the Stanford Track Club are also entered.

Stanford TC entries include Olympian Robin Campbell who has a best of 2:01.23 for 800 meters, and Deanne Johnson, stadium record-holder with 1:01.65 in the 400 meter hurdles.

Cal mainstays are sprinter Kim White (11.94, 24.49), distance runner Cindy Schmandt (9:34.3, 000 meters) and javelin star Christen Engel (162.2).

The Cardinal women defeated the Bears 70-57, and their top entries today are Carol Cady (169-0 discus, 48-10 1/4 shot), Pam Donald (20-5 3/4 long jump), and distance runners Ellen Lyons, Kim Schurpfel and Pattisue Plummer.

In men's meets Saturday, Stanford travels to Washington State, Cal is at Oregon and San Jose State is entered in the West Coast Relays at Fresno.

Stanford coach Brooks Johnson calls Washington State the favorite for the Pacific-10 championship. The Cougars have rolled over Oregon 86-77, Arizona State 96-66 and Washington 99-65 and 91-72 while compiling a 9-0 dual meet record.

WSU boasts outstanding performers in triple jumper Ian Campbell (54-7 1/2), high jumper Doug Nordquist (7-4 1/4), pole vaulter Greg Ernst (17-1 1/4), javelin thrower Laslo Babits (262-10), hammer thrower Paul Buxton (198-7) and sprinter Georges Kablan (10.46, 20.70).

The Bears have lost only to UCLA, but they will need everyone at their best to hurdle the Ducks.
