Mount Pleasant defeated Cupertino, 89-51, and Bellarmine beat Leigh, 76-60, in nonleague meets.

Eric Tennyson and Joe Cerny performed well for Cupertino in the Pioneers' season-opening loss to Mount Pleasant. Tennyson won the shot put (47-2) and discus (117-3) and Cerny won the 100-meter race in 11.74.

Bellarmine sophomore Jeff Pine contributed heavily to the Bells' victory over Leigh, winning the 220 in 23.8 and running the first leg on Bellarmine's winning 440 relay squad. Teammate Brendan Saunders won the 880 in 1:57.5, finished second in the mile and anchored the Bells' winning mile relay team.

In a girls' nonleague meet, Cupertino lost to Mt. Pleasant, 72-37, despite strong showings by Cupertino double-winners Cecilia Saleme and Julie Small.

Saleme won the mile (6:06.4) and two-mile (12:39.0), and Small the shot put (31-0) and discus (97-3).

In another meet Friday, Menlo-Atherton defeated the school's alumni, 77-59. The victory enabled the Bears to avenge an 86-45 loss to the alumni three weeks ago.

M-A's Reggie Dupee, who last year qualified for the CCS trials in the high jump, was a double winner against the alumni in the 120 high hurdles (15.6) and high jump (6-4½). Dupee's effort in the high jump exceeded his best jump last year (in the Central Coast Section Region II finals) by a half-inch.

Thanks largely to sprinter Kenny Smith, Palo Alto High School Monday took a big step toward a second straight Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track title.

Palo Alto, which beat Buchser in an SCVAL opener March 9, already has disposed of two of the league's strongest teams after knocking off visiting Gunn, 87-49.

Best CCS rivalry in track

Usual high-caliber meet between Carlmont, M-A

ATHERTON — No dual-meet track and field rivalry in the Central Coast Section over the past decade has produced the emotion, student-body interest and outstanding marks of the annual Carlmont-Menlo-Atherton showdown for South Peninsula Athletic League supremacy.

And this year's confrontation is not expected to be an exception to that rule.

"Dual-meet wise, both teams probably are among the strongest in the whole Bay Area," says M-A coach Plato Yanicks, whose team takes a three-year, 23-meet unbeaten streak into Thursday's 2:30 p.m. meet against visiting Carlmont.

Yanicks' Bears haven't lost a dual meet since midway through the 1979 season, and not uncoincidentally, Carlmont was their conqueror by a 73-63 score. M-A avenged the loss with last season's victory,

also by 73-63.

Carlmont won the meet in 1978, and M-A was the winner in '77.

This year, Yanicks and Carlmont coach Loren Lansberry expect the meet to be even closer.

Yanicks' pre-meet dope sheet predicts a two-point spread, and it appears likely the final event of the day — the mile relay — will determine the winner.

Carlmont has the advantage in most of the running events, and M-A is expected to score heavily in most of the field events, with the exception of the shotput and pole vault.

Yanicks believes the meet will be decided largely by four athletes who are expected to enter four events — Brian Artist and Ed Berry of Carlmont, and Shawn Smith and Reggie Dupee of M-A. Berry will go head-to-head against Smith in the vital triple-jump competition, and against Dupee in the high hurdles.

Carlmont has a slight edge in depth, but Yanicks feels his team matches up fairly well in most events and isn't likely to be undermined by a glaring weakness anywhere.

In an SPAL meet Tuesday, Woodside defeated host San Carlos 89-44, while San Carlos' girls prevailed, 89-29.

Tim Redick won both hurdles and the 440 to lead Woodside's boys. Rhonda Robinson took both sprints in 11.9 and 26.3 and Cindi

The streak has come to an end

M-A's 23-meet string is broken by Carlmont

Like most track meets between Carlmont and Menlo-Atherton high schools over the years, Thursday's showdown between the South Peninsula Athletic League's two perennial powers was not decided until the final event, the mile relay.

And M-A saw its streak of 23 consecutive dual-meet victories snapped when Carlmont took an early lead in the mile relay and held on to preserve a dramatic 71-64 victory over the host Bears.

The victory virtually clinched the SPAL dual-meet title for Carlmont (4-0). M-A's league record fell to 2-1.

In another SPAL meet, Sequoia rolled up 82 points to outscore Woodside (54 points) and Menlo School (15).

M-A had not lost a dual meet since Carlmont defeated the Bears at M-A in 1979. But M-A coach

Plato Yanicks knew the streak was in danger Thursday.

"A month ago, I didn't think we'd be this close to them," Yanicks said. "We had some (disciplinary) problems earlier in the season, but we did an incredible job of improving in the past few weeks."

M-A, paced by triple-winner Reggie Dupee, led throughout the afternoon until Carlmont took a 66-64 edge just before the mile relay began.

Yanicks said he had a tough time deciding which events sprinter Shawn Smith should compete in.

"A kid can compete in only four events (including relays), and I had to decide whether to put Smith in

the 440 or the mile relay," Yanicks said. "In retrospect, if I'd run Smith in the 440, he probably would have finished at least second and that might have decided the meet before the mile relay."

Instead, Carlmont's Brian Artist and Buster Jamison placed 1-2 in the 440.

Yanicks' strategy backfired when M-A did not win the mile relay, an event Yanicks had expected his team of Kenny Pope, Don Larrick, Elston Coker and Smith to win.

"I thought we had the better mile relay team because we came into the meet with the faster time," Yanicks said. "I thought we would win it."

Smith, M-A's anchorman, gained ground on Carlmont's Jamison. But Carlmont had taken the lead after Berry's strong first leg, and Smith could not overcome the Bears' disadvantage.

Both coaches pointed to Berry (a standout on the Scots' football team last fall) as a key figure.

"Berry was the thorn in our side," Yanicks said. "He was their main star and probably the guy who hurt us most."

In addition to competing on Carlmont's winning mile relay team, Berry placed first in the long jump (21-2) and finished second in the 120 high hurdles race and triple jump.

Although M-A's Smith placed first in the triple jump, Berry's effort in that event was good enough to beat M-A's Joe Sterling, the defending SPAL triple-jump champion.

"Berry, Artist and Jamison all were key figures for us," Carlmont coach Loren Lansberry said. "Everything else went pretty much the way it was doped out."

Another key figure for Carlmont was distance runner Ron Gomez, who won both the mile and the 2-mile races.

Dupee and Bobby Alexander were among M-A's standouts. Dupee won the 120 high hurdles

and 330 low hurdles and also high-jumped 6-6. Alexander placed second in the 100 and high jump.

Woodside sprinter Tim Reddick was a double winner in the 440 (52.2) and 330 low hurdles (40.3), but his efforts were not enough to prevent Sequoia from defeating the Wildcats.

In an SPAL girls' meet, Carlmont lifted its record to 5-0 with an 82-32 victory over M-A. No score was kept in another girls' meet between

host Woodside and Menlo School, Sequoia, Mercy and Sacred Heart of Menlo Park.

Carlmont's Gia Carrozzi had a fine mark of 40-6 in the shot put and also won the discus throw with a mark of 110-6. Carlmont freshmen Linda Matoso, Sandy Morgan and Nancy Jones teamed with sophomore Kathy Nieder to win the mile relay.

M-A's Nora Williams was a double winner in the mile and two-mile, but Carlmont's Paula Foianini won the 440 and 880.
