# Los Angeles City Sectional Championships

May 20. "Tom Bradley Stadium" at Birm-Ingham High School (Van Nuya). On Friday evening, May 20th, the 49 school Los Angeles Section came together for its forty-ninth annual Cham-pionship Meet. With a number of the state's top athletes involved there were a number of fine marks and solid competi-tion. After years on the dirt track of East LA College, the Section moved to the very good looking track donated by the ARCO Oil Company as part of its Olympic Games preparation project—the all-weather surface here made for many super times

Highlighting the Meet was the continued return to form of Hamilton's Antonio Manning in the Men's Sprints. Having suffered an ankle injury in mid-April's Arcadia invitational, Antonio has been under the care of the "magic-fingers" man, Dr. Leroy Perry. conditioning. It must be working, because Manning put together three fine efforts here. Antonio lifted his 400 relay team to a new City Record with a 41.34 clocking, got rolling after about 60 meters in the 100 in a 10.63 MR win there, and finished the day off with a strong final 100 in a 20.95w (6.5 mph) 200 triumph. Manning led his team to victory with 30 points.

Over in the Ladies division it was the middle distance running of Westchester's Trescla Palmer, Kennedy (Granada Hills) star Paula Bresnan, and all-over-the-place running of Choo-Choo Knighten (Locke). Trescia, in the 800 totally soloed 29.2-61.2-1:34.4 splits on the way to a 2:06.57 MR and state-leading clocking. The duel between Miss Palmer and a strong Kerri Zaleski (Millikan, Long Beach-Southern Section) should be in-teresting. Paula Bresnan, an Illinois transfer a couple of years back, led her Kennedy squad to the team title with two victories. After a solo 4:50.0 1600 in the previous week's qualifying, Paula seemed content with a 5:00.62 win here. A 3200 win for Paula was suprising, as she easily handled Katle Dunsmuir (Palisades) 10:47.24-10:50.10. Dunsmuir had raced 10:27.6 in qualifying, but had suffered a rotated meniscus of the right knee since that time, and was definitely at less than 100 percent when Bresnan eased by with 300 meters to go in the race. Sophomore Chewaukil (Indian name) Knighten of Locke is something else. She was 2nd in the 100M to Robin Simmons (Crenshaw) 11.86-11.96, took the 100MLH in a quick 14.04, raced to a 54.14 400M win, and brought her 1600M Relay squad from iast to 2nd with a 52.4 relay leg.

Robin Simmons (Crenshaw) had a hand in two other wins, as her 24.21 took im-proved Monica Phillips (Kennedy, GH) 24.37 over 200M, and Robin's super an chor leg helped her team past Dorsey's super stick work and Phillip's strong last leg in a 46.73 (C), 47.00 (K), and 47.01 (D) exciting 400M Relay. Crenshaw also took the 1600 Relay at 3:51.19, with the other top female efforts being Kim Hall's 5'6" high jump for Kennedy, Rose Faamal (Kennedy) 41'%" shot put win, and Melissa King (Fremont soph) who went 43.75 over 300M LH.

Daymon Lee (South Gate) led the rest of the Men's events with a weil-paced 47.88 400M win. Manual Arts middle distance runners Ed Daily (1:53.19 800M win) and Darryle Peoples (4:17.91 1600M win) both showed excellent pacing and tactics in their victories. Belmont soph Roman Gomez was 2nd over 1600M (4:20.21) and returned to win the 3200M at 9:28.71. Darnell Christman (Locke) powered a city-record 36.74 300M LH, Anthony Reynolds (Fremont) took the Highs at 14.56, and Banning (Wilmington) took the 1600 Relay at 3:15.67.
