

Brown beats Smith twice in Sunkist track

Ron Brown, whose dreams of an Olympic medal made him pass up a lucrative pro football contract, scored an impressive double in Friday night's Sunkist Invitational indoor track and field meet, winning both the 50- and 60-yard dashes in Los Angeles.

Brown, the former Arizona State wide receiver who rejected a reported \$900,000 offer to play with the Cleveland Browns, beat outdoor 100-meter world-record holder Calvin Smith in both the sprints.

Brown was timed in 5.32 in the 50 and in 6.16 in the 60. Smith, who set the 100-meter record of 9.93 last year in Colorado Springs, finished third in the 50 and fifth in the 60.

Other highlights of the meet were provided by Czechoslovakian runner Jarmila Kratochvilova, miler Steve Scott and pole vaulter Billy Olson.

Kratochvilova, the world record-holder in the women's 400 and 800 meters, won the 880-yard race with a 2:02.8.

Scott, who has run the second-fastest outdoor mile ever, won the mile on the boards in 3:57.69. Olson, after two straight meets of no-heighting, finally won with a season-best 18-8 $\frac{1}{4}$. He missed three times at a world-best 19-1. France's Pierre Quinon, who finished second with more misses at 18-8 $\frac{1}{4}$, failed twice at 19-1 before passing on his final turn.
