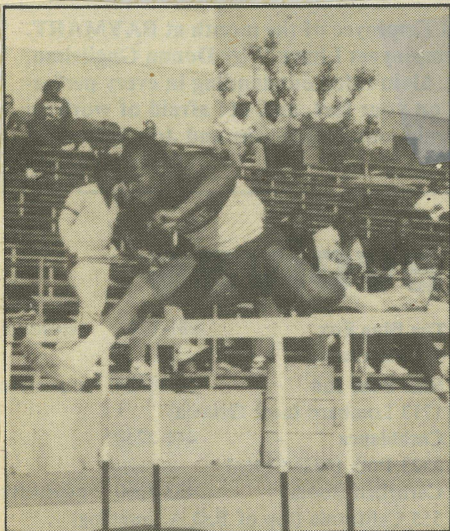
Runners ready for all league final matches

Brooks leads 'Cats to victory

Ronda Brooks led the Oakland Wildcats to the girls' championship in the Oakland Athletic League meet with the Academic Athletic Association yesterday at Laney College.

Brooks won the 300-meter low hurdles and ran on two winning relay teams for the Wildcats,

who amassed 102 points to take the title over second place Lowell with 90.

Galileo ran away from the rest of the field in the boys division, racking up 131 points to Oakland's second place finish with 57.

The winner of each event will compete in the California State Championships next Friday and Saturday at Hughes Stadium in Sacramento.

Brooks' time of 41.6 in the 300 low hurdles smashed her personal best of 42.3 and gives the sophomore the fastest clocking on the Eastbay's all-time list. The previous record of 42.37 was set by Sherifa Sanders of Berkeley in 1981.

Brooks also ran the second leg on the 400-meter relay and the anchor on the 1,600-meter relay to lead Oakland to two wins.

Oakland's boys 400-meter relay team crossed the finish line first, but was disqualified.

With the recent addition of Charles Brooks to the squad, the foursome ran a 41.6 to apparently win the event and best their Eastbay season's record by six-tenths of a second.

But anchorman Eric Broussard threw the baton onto the infield after crossing the tape. According to Section 2 of the league rule book, that is grounds for disqualification.
