# Strong efforts in Jenner

## St. Francis' girls record victories in 440, mile relays

SAN JOSE — Greg Sledge and Andreen Alvarenga of Mitty High School and Buffy Sexton of Mills provided the only individual victories by athletes representing Peninsula schools Saturday at the Bruce Jenner Classic at San Jose City College.

In addition to the individual victories, the St. Francis girls won the 440 and mile relays, the former with a 48.12 and the latter in 3:57.8. Both are leading times in the Central Coast Section.

Although individuals like JoAnn Arnold of Palo Alto, Ben White of Carmont and Scott Robinson of Bellarmine were not among the winners, each of them posted personal records in a meet that drew many of the top competitors from Northern California.

Alvarenga, winner of the CCS 400-

meter championship last season as a freshman, returned to that form by winning the event in 56.15, just ahead of freshman Roslyn Mack of St. Francis, who ran 56.40. Roslyn ran a 57.8 anchor on the winning mile relay team and also was a member of the winning 440 relay unit.

"We are all real happy with the relays," Mack said. "The 440 relay time is a school record, so we are pleased with that performance."

Running ahead of Roslyn in the mile relay were her twin sister Joslyn (58.1 split), Shelle Quinn (63.1) and Karen Lawson (58.8).

"The best part about it is we'll all be back next year," Joslyn Mack said. "Karen is a junior and the rest of us on the mile relay are freshmen."

The Mack twins and Jennifer Jackson ran ahead of Lawson in the 440 relay.

Sledge won the first section of the boys 400 in 49.09 and that held up for the victory over Robert Myles of North Monterey County, who won the second

section in 49.15. Sexton, the CCS leader in both weight events, won the discus with a 125-1 toss and had the unusual experience of recording a personal record of 41-9 while finishing second in the shot put. It was her first defeat of the season in that event.

"It was nice to do well in the discus again. Mac Wilkins (an Olympic champion in that event) pointed out some of my problems in that event," Sexton said. "The technique is more complicated in the discus; problems in the shot are easier to correct."

She has been consistent in the shot put and it reflected in her series Saturday. She fouled on her first throw in the finals, but all but one effort was beyond 40-0. She started with a 40-10½ and followed with 39-11¾, 41-9, foul, 40-4¾ and 40-2. Jane Tables of Vacaville won with a 42-1½ throw and her next best mark was 35-1¼.

Arnold was third in the girls' 800 but her 2:17.5 is the best of her life.

"I didn't win, but I am very excited," Arnold said. "It was nice and warm and there was a fast pace. I am going to try the 400 hurdles at the West Valley meet next week."

Palo Alto coach Paul Jones lauded Arnold's effort as well as that of Aoiffe Dowley who was fifth in 2:20.7.

"That makes JoAnn first in the CCS and Dowley has to be among the leaders as well," Jones said. "The nice thing is both are very diligent workers who return next year. Arnold is a sophomore and Dowley is a junior."

White jumped a personal best 23-3 for third in the long jump and Robinson took more than a second off his personal best with his 1:56.2 for fifth in the 800.

Other noteworthy efforts included Menlo-Atherton's Chris Moura, whose 55.93 took third in the 400 intermediate hurdles, and teammate Roland Anderson, who was second in the shot put with a 56-4 mark. Mark Callon of Bellarmine was second in the 5,000 meters in 15:16.5.

Chip Vargas of Wilcox ran a 10.88, good for third place in the 100 meters, and Peter Kolotouris of Lynbrook was second in the 110 meter high hurdles in 14.64 behind sophomore John Montgomery of Independence, who won in 14.50.

Rebecca Chamberlain of Leigh posted the best time in the nation with her 9:35.5 victory in the 3,000 meters and returned later to win the 1,500 in 4:40.9. Effie Daetz, a junior from Leigh, won the 100 meter low hurdles in 14.00, the second swiftest clocking in the nation.
