Bunnell, Sexton take shot titles; Arnett wins vault

GILROY — Scott Bunnell and Buffy Sexton won titles in the shot put with significant efforts at the Gilroy Invitational track and field meet on a windy Saturday at Gilroy High School.

Gunn's Bunnell took the boys' shot put with a season-best 58-9 $\frac{3}{4}$, while Sexton, of Mills, won her second straight Gilroy girls' shot put crown with a 40-5 $\frac{1}{2}$ toss.

Todd Arnett of Los Altos won the pole vault at 14-6 and Scott Robinson of Bellarmine claimed the mile in 4:29.43 to take the only other victories by Peninsula athletes. Robinson won a duel with Dan Gabor of Amador Valley.

Bunnell displayed his best form of the season after recovering from an ailment incurred on a church-sponsored trip to Mexico during the Easter break. The shot was held in the day and Bunnell returned home after the event.

"His performance today is encouraging," Gunn co-coach Bob Peters said. "He lost in conditioning after his return from Mexico. He sapped all his strength just doing 54-0 last week, so his effort today is very encouraging."

Sexton's victory in the shot put came after her biggest disappointment of the season, a 109-9 for fifth in the discus. She won both the shot and discus to claim field athlete of the meet honors a year ago.

"Going over 40-0 (in the shot) is

a relief after doing so poorly in the discus," Sexton said. "At least I've shown consistency in the shot, but I don't know what went wrong in the discus. I just had no clue to what I was doing wrong."

Arnett's effort in the pole vault also was outstanding, especially considering the windy conditions.

Bellarmine finished third in the boys' scoring with 48 points. Riordan won with 61 points to 51 for Independence. Mitty and Gunn tied for eighth with 16 points.

Piedmont Hills edged Leland, 50-49, to win the girls' title. Palo Alto finished fifth with 27 points and Mitty was eighth with 23.

Fremont tied for ninth with 22 points as sophomore Brook Bartholomew placed second with a 37-5 mark in the triple jump for the Indians.

Palo Alto was led by JoAnne Arnold, who was second with a 2:23.74 in the 800. She capped the meet with a 62.4 leg on Paly's mile relay team, which finished sixth in 4:19.38.

Arnold, however, was more impressed with her team's fifth place finish with 27 points.

"Hey, we didn't do bad for having so few girls here," Arnold said.

"I was really surprised to hear we finished fifth, and we were only one point out of fourth place."

Independence competed without sprint-hurdles star Billy Gaines but claimed the meet's outstanding track athlete in sophomore John Montgomery, who won the 110-meter high hurdles in 14.29 and the 330 intermediates in 38.75. He also ran legs on his school's runner-up mile and 440-yard relay units.

Reggie Jackson of Riordan was

voted the top field athlete. He won the triple jump at 45-11 $\frac{3}{4}$ and was second in the long jump at 22-8.

Gina Albanese of Branham claimed the only meet record with a 45.04 in the 330-yard low hurdles, erasing the 45.2 by Roberta Eccles of Gunderson in 1982.

Field athlete laurels went to junior Stacie Haro of the host school with an impressive 38-5 $\frac{1}{4}$ triple jump and 17-11 long jump, both winning marks.
