Gunn, Palo Alto win titles

Titan boys, Viking girls take SCVAL team honors

It was just a matter of time for Gunn High School's Scott Bunnell, in his coach's opinion — and that time arrived Saturday.

Bunnell got off an effort of 60 feet, one inch in the shot put in the Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track and field finals at Foothill College.

Two weeks ago, when Bunnell threw the shot put 59-10 $\frac{1}{4}$ in the Top Eight Invitational meet, Gunn coach Bob Peters said it was just a matter of time until Bunnell hit the 60-foot mark. Saturday, Bunnell proved his coach right.

Bunnell also won the discus with a throw of 154-4 $\frac{1}{2}$ to help Gunn win the boys' team title with 160 points. Wilcox was second with 82.

"It feels pretty good to see that '60' on the tape," Bunnell said of his school record. "I felt good today despite the heat. The big rea-

been sidelined most of the season due to an injury, and from Kanik Chung in the long jump with a life-best 22-1.

Wilcox's Chip Vargas won the 100 meters and 220 and ran an outstanding leadoff leg on the winning 440 relay squad. Wilcox ran a season-best 43.5, while favored Gunn ran a season-best 43.7.

Wilcox's Denis Carmichael, who anchored the 440 relay, won the triple jump at 45-2 $\frac{1}{2}$, more than a foot farther than his previous best.

Mountain View's Craig Blockhus did his usual yeoman job. Blockhus was a triple winner, running the 880 (1:56.2) and mile (4:22.8) in season bests and also taking the two-mile (9:52.3).

Blockhus' mile was his most impressive event. On a day when temperatures on the track were in the 90s and most distance runners showed the effects, Blockhus overcame the stifling heat to win the mile by 21 seconds after already having run two races.

"I wanted to run a hard mile to show people I could do it," Blockhus said. "I've been doing all this tripling so that I can still run hard when I'm tired. Now, I feel I've got the stamina, foot speed and preparation to run against the big guys at the state meet."

Girls

Palo Alto won the championship with 164 points to 147 for Gunn.

Mary Karen Olson and Laura Van turned in solid performances for the Vikings.

Van won the 100 meters (12.2), 220-yard race (25.7) and triple jump (36-3 $\frac{1}{4}$) and also anchored the winning 440 relay team. Van's triple jump was a life best by more than a foot.

Olson won the 330 hurdles (46.8) and long jump (a life-best 17-6 $\frac{1}{2}$) and placed second to Gunn's Jill Grumet in the 100-meter hurdles.

"I can't believe it," Olson said of her mark in the long jump. "Now I want to jump 18 feet."

Mountain View's Shannon Clark was a double winner, taking the mile (5:15.3) and two-mile (11:09.4). Clark, the two-time defending state champion in the mile, plans to concentrate on that event.

Palo Alto's JoAnn Arnold finished second to Clark in the mile and two-mile and won the 880.

Derrick Florence of Galveston Ball ran the second-fastest high school 100 meters this season by clocking 10.1 seconds in Texas' state high school track and field meet Saturday in Austin.

Florence also holds the year's fastest clocking of 10.29.

son for the 60-footer was that I got under the throw and got it up in the air.

Peters was as happy as Bunnell.

"Scott usually does well in a real competitive situation, so it was gratifying that he could do it today," Peters said, noting the second-place throw was only 49-3.

"Now he's got the monkey of 60 feet off his back. I don't think he's reached his peak. He's still in the foothills, with the mountain of the state meet to climb."
