The Pac-10—the Conference of Champions—continues to live up to its billing as having the strongest overall athletic program in the country in comparison to the rest of the nation's conferences.

In 1988-89, the Pac-10 picked up six more men's and women's team championships (water polo, men's volleyball, softball, women's swimming and diving, and men's and women's tennis) to match the Southeastern Conference for the nation's top mark. Pac-10 members have now won 190 NCAA men's team championships (far ahead of the Big Ten's 135) and 24 women's crowns (the SEC has 15) to lead the country in both categories. The Conference also fared well in non-NCAA Championship events, winning two of three football bowl games (UCLA in the Mobil Cotton and Washington State in the Eagle Aloha), and Arizona State's national team titles in men's, women's, and combined archery, and men's, women's and combined badminton.

Pac-10 men's programs have won at least four NCAA team titles in 16 of the last 19 years, a feat unprecedented in intercollegiate athletics.

The NCAA team titles have come at a phenomenal rate—13 basketball titles, more than any other conference; 16 of the last 23 baseball titles; 18 of the last 30 and an incredible 44 titles overall in track and field; 15 of the last 26 in swimming; 27 of the last 30 in tennis; 18 of the last 30 in water polo; and 16 of the last 20 in volleyball.

The story is the same on the women's side. The NCAA has been conducting women's championships for eight years and Pac-10 members have won four team titles four times. Included in the NCAA team titles are all eight tennis crowns, and five out of the eight championships in softball.

The roots of the Pacific-10 Conference go back nearly 75 years. On December 9, 1915, the Pacific Coast Conference was founded at a meeting at the Oregon Hotel in Portland, Oregon. Original membership

consisted of four schools—University of California, University of Washington, University of Oregon, and Oregon State College (now Oregon State University).

Pacific Coast Conference play began in 1916. One year later, Washington State College (now Washington State University) was accepted into the PCC, and Stanford University joined in 1918.

In 1922, the PCC expanded to eight teams with the admission of the University of Southern California and the University of Idaho. Montana joined the Conference in 1924 and in 1928 the PCC grew to 10 members with the addition of UCLA.

The Pacific Coast Conference competed as a 10-team league until 1950 with the exception of 1943-45 when World War II somewhat curtailed athletic competition at the university level. In 1950, Montana resigned from the Conference and joined the Mountain States Conference. The PCC continued as a nine-team conference through 1958.

In 1959, the PCC dissolved and a new conference was formed called the Athletic Association of Western Universities. Original AAWU membership consisted of California, Stanford, Southern California, UCLA, and Washington. Washington State became a member in 1962 with Oregon and Oregon State joining in 1964. In 1968, the name Pacific-8 Conference was adopted.

Ten years later, on July 1, 1978, the University of Arizona and Arizona State University were admitted and the Pacific-10 Conference became a reality. In 1986-87, the Conference expanded to include ten women's sports.

Edwin N. Atherton was named the Conference's first Commissioner in 1940. He has been succeeded by Victor O. Schmidt (1944), Thomas J. Hamilton (1959), Wiles Hallock (1971), and Thomas C. Hansen (1983).

NCAA QUALIFYING STANDARDS

For the 1990 Division I Men's and Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championships, the NCAA Executive Committee has approved both an automatic and provisional qualifying standard for each event. The provisional standard was adopted in order to fill each event with a minimum number of entries, as selected by the Committee.

All eligible student-athletes who meet the automatic standard may compete and will not be subject to elimination because of restrictions in field sizes. If needed, performances meeting provisional standards will be used to develop a descending-order list to fill the event minimum.

Following are the 1990 NCAA automatic and provisional qualifying standards as well as the minimum field sizes for each event.
