Two Mills runners breeze to titles in Stanford meet

After Alva Dancel won the 3,000-meter run, the Mills High senior knew that classmate Paul Eley would win the boys 5,000 later in the day.

And that's what happened during the opening day of the high school portion of the Stanford Invitational track meet at Stanford Stadium on Friday.

Competition resumes this morning at 8 o'clock with the men's open 10,000-meter run.

The first high school track event will be the first heat of the boys 400 relay at 9:30 a.m. Field events start with the girls shot put and boys discus at 8:30.

Dancel won her race in 10:22, well ahead of Lisa Lopez of Balboa of San Francisco. Lopez was second in 10:38.

"I am a lot stronger and I'm running faster than a year ago at this time," Dancel said. "I am where I want to be.

"I am happy for Paul, too. It seems we finish in the same spot at each meet. The pressure was on him this time to do what I did. I knew he would and he did it in impressive fashion."

Eley won a race in which Peninsula runners grabbed the first five positions and seven of the first eight. Eley was a runaway winner in 15:10, well ahead of Derek Waxman of San Mateo. Waxman made a late run to take second in 15:22.

John Hannon of Woodside was third in 15:31, Russ Crandall of San Mateo was fourth in 15:50 and Dan Zoldak of Bellarmine fifth in 15:51. Andy Bupp of Woodside wound up seventh in 16:04 and Kyle Dando of Bellarmine was eighth in 15:51.

"I wanted to break 15 minutes," Eley said. "I might have had a chance to do so if someone was pressing after that first mile."

Eley took the lead early in the race and was comfortably ahead after the first mile. He was even farther ahead after two miles, which he negotiated in 9:36.

"I prefer the longer distances. This was my best ever by 21 seconds for this distance," Eley said. "I want to break 9:10 in the two mile, win the CCS and qualify for the state meet. I know those who were behind me today will be a lot stronger later in the season."

Tim Baxter of Bellarmine won the boys 400 intermediate hurdles, and a quartet of Woodside girls won the shuttle hurdles relay for the only other victories by Peninsula athletes.

Baxter won easily in 56.71, his best in four tries at the distance.

"I came into the last turn with a
