

Giusto makes track history

SAN FRANCISCO — Matt Giusto made Bay Area outdoor running history Saturday. He ran a sub-4-minute mile at Kezar Stadium.

Giusto, the ex-San Mateo High runner, won Kezar Mizuno Invitational mile in a record time of 3:55.63.

Actually, Giusto was one of four runners who broke the 4-minute barrier. The other three were Greg Whiteley, Aaron Ramirez and Jim Sorenson.

Giusto, 26, who lives in Portola Valley, won \$5,000 in prize money for his Saturday effort.

At San Mateo High, Guisto was tutored by the late Don Dooley.
