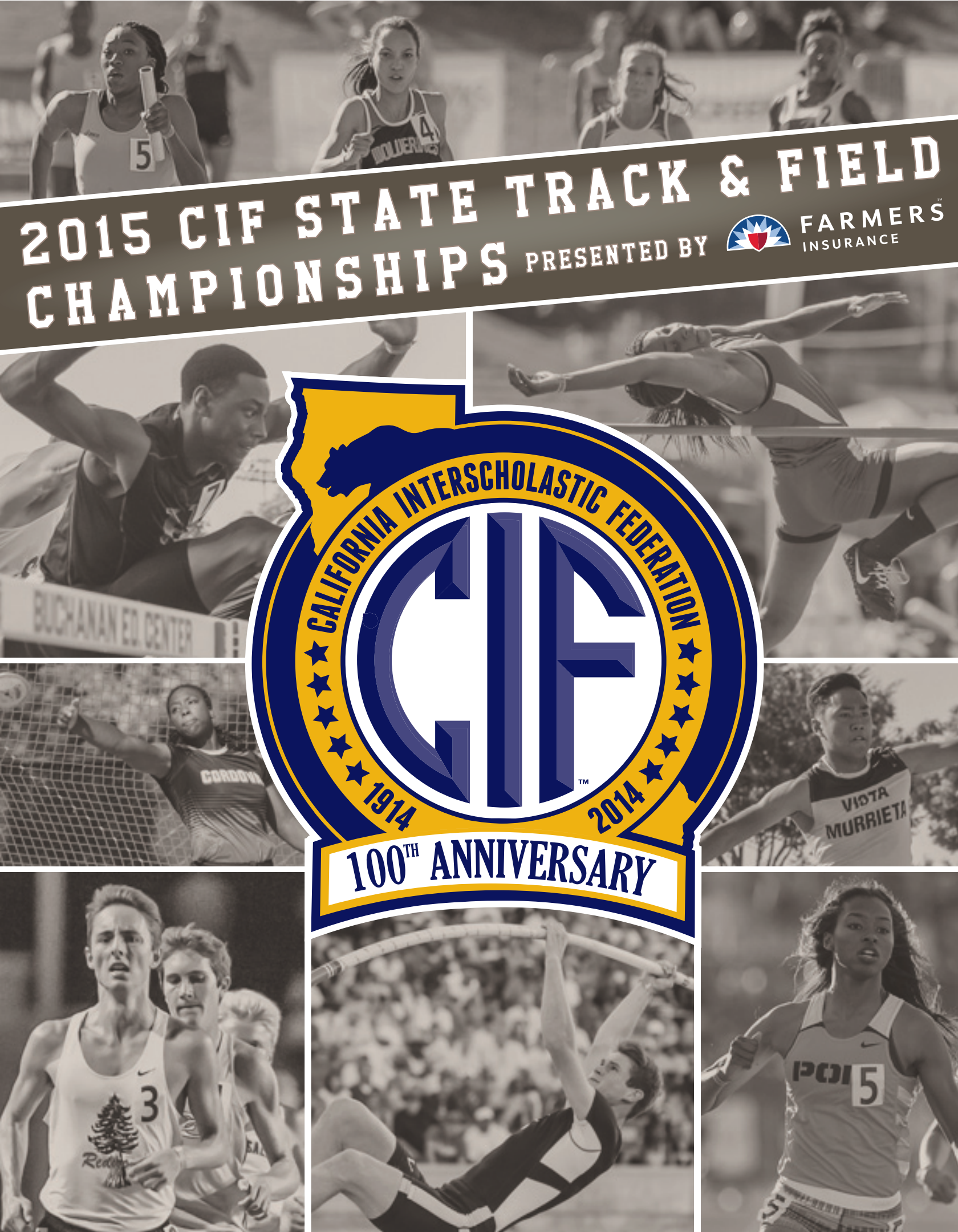

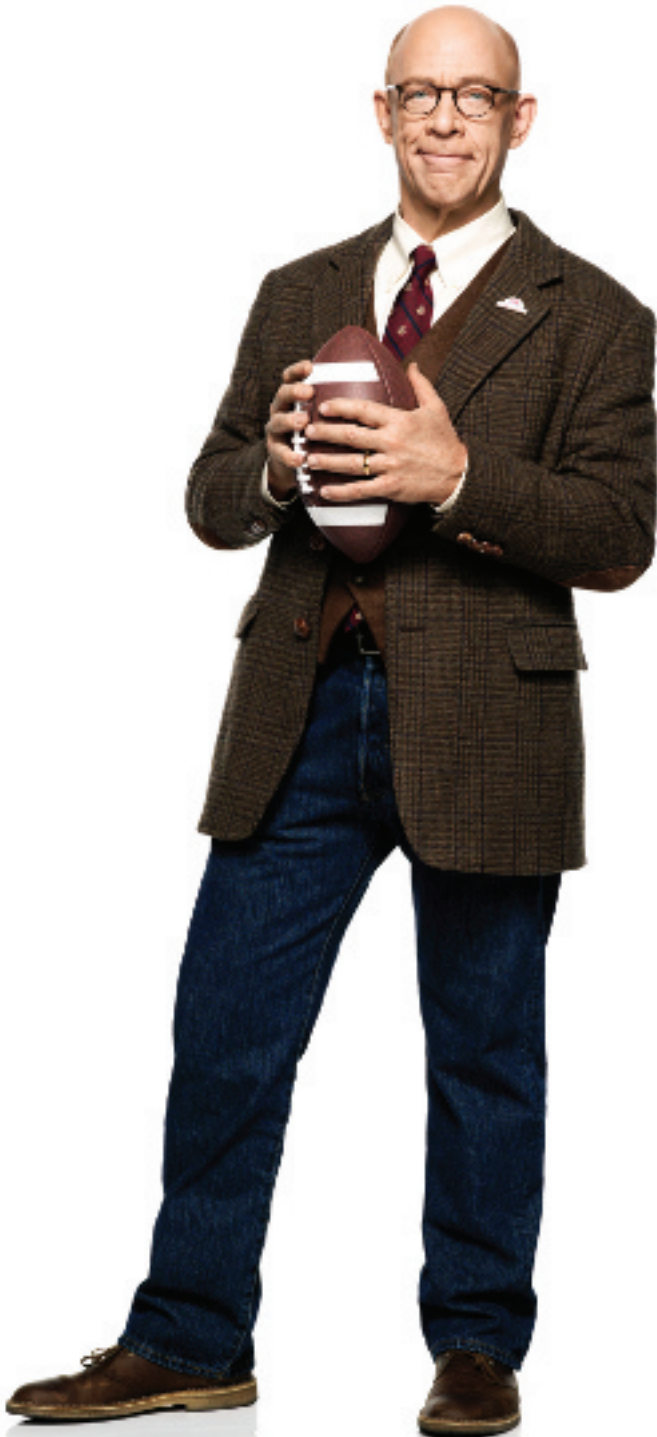

Pursuing Victory With Honorsm

This year we celebrate the 100 Year Anniversary of the California Interscholastic Federation as a statewide education based athletic organization. The CIF was formed and had its humble beginning during the 1914-1915 school year with only 65,927 total high school students in California and it has been estimated that less than 8,000 boys were participating on their high school athletic teams. Today, California high schools boast over 1.9 million students and this past school year almost 800,000 students participated in sports on our campuses in California.

During these 100 years, high school sports has transformed from an important local community event to one that it is commonly seen on broadcast television and the Internet with full-time websites dedicated to recruiting and blogging about teams, student-athletes and coaches. Most however, still refer to education-based athletics as the last "true amateur sport" venue in America because our mission and value system is based upon the core foundation of student participation, sportsmanship and fair play. While professional sports, collegiate athletics and even most youth programs have moved toward a business model where finances, positive income and winning is the sole mission, high school sports still remains dedicated to providing opportunities for kids to compete in a safe and fair environment.

Sports add richness to a school culture by providing opportunities for any student who wants them. It is the largest "elective" program on any high school campus. Nationally, and here in California, participation by

students in high school sports programs is at its highest level in history proving the desire and need is vast. In the process of deriving enjoyment from participation (Number one reason kids play sports: Fun) in athletics, our students are learning life-long skills that help them develop into healthy adults and productive citizens. National research continues to validate that students involved in extracurricular activities attend more days of school, perform better in the classroom, and have less behavior issues at school; lower dropout rates and lower alcohol and drug abuse rates, than students who do not participate. The data and the lists of participation benefits are endless.

It is true that we occasionally see acts of poor sportsmanship and behavior by a player or a coach, but the overwhelming majority of school contests reflect the positive elements of Pursuing Victory with Honorsm. True, the goal is always to win the contest, but high school sports, when done correctly, places the value

of life lessons, character and sportsmanship ahead of winning. It is this ability of education based sports leaders to keep athletics in its proper perspective that helps separate us from the rest.

It is vital that as sports leaders, parents and fans that we must remember that less than 2% of our participating students will go on and compete in athletics in college. Kids participate in sports because it's fun and the athletic fields and gymnasium classrooms our schools provide gives adults the opportunity to teach valuable lessons that might not be learned in any other environment. As educational leaders, creating life-long skills and helping create better citizens through participation in education based athletics is the greatest gift we can give to the future.

Help us create the same atmosphere that has allowed a "Century" of California students to gain a love of competition and personal growth that will help them mature into productive and caring citizens through their participation in sports. As you enjoy these Championship contests, please help by teaching and demonstrating respect. Displays of good sportsmanship will say positive things about you and your school community, and hopefully remind us all that in the end, sport is meant to be fun and enjoyed by not only those participating, but those in attendance.

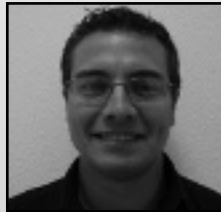

2015 State Track & Field Championships Preview

Speed, Power Area Familiar Calling Cards

For Nation's Premier State Meet

There is something special in the Clovis air on the opening weekend of each June. High-flying aerialists, spiraling implements, speeding dashers, soaring jumpers, and quick-spinning race kicks, just to name a few. In many cases, that rate of movement is unmatched, leading to a flurry of nation-leading marks and periodic national record achievements as well. At this weekend's 97th annual CIF State Track and Field Championships, Presented by Farmers, expect to have more of the same.

Headlined by America's premier long dasher and its best shot putter on the boys' side and a quartet of precocious wunderkinds on the girls' side, we're once again set to witness something pretty special. Vista Murrieta/SS High School's Michael Norman, fresh off a junior class state record performance at 200 meters, and St. John Bosco/SS senior Matt Katnik, the Southern Section record holder in the shot put, lead a special set of male performers for this year's gathering at Buchanan High's Veterans Memorial Stadium. But there could be even more fireworks emanating from the girls' competition, where dash phenoms Lauren Williams (Oaks Christian/SS) and Zaria Francis (Rio Mesa/SS) continue their exciting duel while Roosevelt/SS hurdler Jasmyne Graham and Agoura/SS do-it-all Tara Davis electrify the crowds as well! With the Central Valley's simmering weather combined with Buchanan

High's ultra-fast Mondo track surface, expect to hear a collective plethora of oooohs and aaaahs while witnessing America's finest state track and field meet: The CIF State Track and Field Championships, Presented by Farmers!

Here's our mini-preview for each event on meet weekend:

BOYS SPRINTS & RELAYS

The Golden State has played host to premier dash names the likes of Henry Thomas, Quincy Watts, Obea Moore and Bryshon Nellum over the years, but Vista Murrieta's Michael Norman is set to write his own history in joining that illustrious cast. Norman's jaw-dropping talents in the long dashes have resulted in a nation-leading 20.46 for 200 meters at last week's Southern Section Masters Meet while his 45.91 for the one lapper led the landscape for much of 2015 as well. Norman will undertake both dashes and be involved in both sprint relays (including a state-leading 40.53 unit in the 4x100 relay) in leading Vista Murrieta's bid for the overall team title. With Tony Mitchell, Jordan Testerman, Cole Dubots, Ricky Adams and Kris Handy joining Norman, the Vista Murrieta "Speed Factory" has more than enough interchangeability to rack up precious major points in the baton events.

With Norman the heavy favorite at 400m, the battle should be for the runner-up position, where Long Beach Wilson's Mar'yea Harris and Chaminade's Greg Campbell have been dazzling this spring, with Woodbridge mega-talent Gabe Warner finding a higher gear in recent outings as well. Damien/SS sopho-

more Zach Shinnick is another gem to keep an eye on.

Norman has the clear edge in the half-lap dash as well after torching vaunted Chaminade speedster T.J. Brock by large margin in their SS clash last weekend. Brock has been phenomenal this year, especially in the 100, where he has twice clocked wind-aided times of 10.20, the second fastest in state annals under any conditions. But Lincoln of Stockton's John McDonald (10.50/21/34) has been performing magical feats of his own up north and will keep heavy pressure on Brock in their duels. Alemany's Dominic Davis, the aforementioned Mitchell of Vista Murrieta and Damien's dynamic duo of Shinnick and Thaddeus Smith are additional prime talents.

In the relays, Vista Murrieta will battle Chaminade and Notre Dame/SS for bragging rights, with those same combatants being lead contenders for the team championship as well. In the long relay, Long Beach Wilson is fresh off a school record and state-leading 3:13.61, but Vista Murrieta (despite a likely weary Norman by the end of the meet), Cathedral, Notre Dame and Roosevelt are the heavy hitters here.

With speed once again being the name of the game, Vista Murrieta is favored over Chaminade for the overall team championship, with Notre Dame, Damien and Kingsburg among those projected to battle for third.

BOYS THROWS

St. John Bosco senior Matt Katnik has also been the talk of the nation this spring after a series of

prodigious launches in the shot put tagging him as the landslide favorite here. Katnik, whose season-best 72-03.00 is easily the national leader this spring, broke the Southern Section postseason record with his 70-11.50 toss at Masters last weekend. West Ranch weight man Nathan Bultman, Valencia/SS senior Nick Coghill and Esperanza/SS sophomore Bronson Osborn are additional leading entrants.

In the discus throw, Mater Dei/SS senior Malik McMorris led the nation for much of the year with his toss of 194-08, but Los Osos' Michael Pertusati (192-08) has been quietly creeping up on the defending state champion with the biggest meet now here. Oceanside's Charles Lenford was the latest to join the 190-foot club last weekend at the San Diego Section Finals, with all throwers here looking to ride the Clovis winds to nice personal bests.

BOYS DISTANCES

The Golden State has traditionally led the parade of national-caliber talent when it comes to wealth in the distance races, but this year's crop at 3200 meters might be deeper than ever! With nine entrants already having run nine minutes or faster for the eight-lapper, the field is overstuffed with talent. By Saturday night's end, finishers outside of the top dozen will likely have run a time fast enough to win 45 of the other state meets in the nation. Geez. Leading the way here are Saugus' Brian Zabilski, who stunned all with a state-best 8:49.38 at last week's SS Masters, as well as Southland talents Caleb Webb (Big Bear/SS) and Robert Brandt (Loyola/SS), the latter having bettered 9:00 five times this season. Madera South's Eduardo Herrera, Saratoga's Steven Sum and

Canyon of Anaheim's Wesley Walsh are additional top talents in this star-studded cast.

The 1600-meter run features two Orange County athletes at the forefront, with heavy preseason favorite Austin Tamagno (Brea-Olinda/SS) weathering through lengthy sickness to impressively win the SS Masters Meet while Huntington Beach's George Gleason has developed nicely as a senior, with his tall frame and galloping stride being tough to match down the stretch. Bonita sophomore Dillon Beckum – he of the neon socks and free spirit – and San Luis Obispo ace William Ernst along with the San Diego tandem of Erik Armes (Coronado) and Alex Merder (La Costa Canyon) are key ones to watch.

Thrills and chills should envelop the final moments of the 800-meter run, where Central Section rivals Connor Morello of Clovis/CE (last year's silver medalist) and Isaac Trevino of Centennial/CE were credited with identical state-leading times (1:51.39) at their Masters Meet while Los Alamitos' Thomas Heib captured gold at the Southern Section Masters (1:51.49). Temescal Canyon senior Cobie Chavez had made a big late-season splash but Great Oak's Isaac Cortes should be extra dangerous while dropping the 1600 to focus on a single event this weekend!

BOYS VERTICAL JUMPS

Aerial action should be as exciting as always at the state meet, where a cast of new stars soar skyward. In the pole vault, Steven French on Lompoc Cabrillo/SS grabbed the state lead with an eye-popping 16-10 clearance at the Los Padres League Finals early last month, but vastly improved Oak

Ridge/SJ senior Austin Laut has truly enjoyed the "Midas touch" in mining gold at several major meets while being unbeaten this spring! The Sac-Joaquin Section checks in with two more leading 16 footers in Nate Harper and Michael Gonzalez while Orange County boasts a sky-is-the-limit talent in Marina junior Jett Gordon.

The high jump competition courts storylines on multiple fronts, with three athletes atop the state lists with 7-foot jumps, including indoor state invitational champion Michael Burke of Lemoore, St. Francis/CC junior Darius Thomas and Oakmont/SJ junior Isaiah Holmes. Also in the field is top returnee C.J. McCord of Sage Hill/SS, who placed fourth last year. Trabuco Hills' Sean Lee, a multi-time age-group world record holder who has cleared 6-09 as a freshman (!) this season, arrives here with limited 2015 competitions and very fresh legs.

BOYS HURDLES

Barring the unexpected, the battle for high hurdles supremacy should evolve on the continuing battle between state leader Alex Billing of Simi Valley and the newly minted sophomore-class state record holder in Upland's Joseph Anderson. Billing owns the state's fastest wind legal time (13.79) and prevailed by 0.02 in their SS Masters showdown last weekend (when Anderson broke the 10th-grade state record), but Anderson was the higher placer between the two at both the Arcadia Invitational and the Mt. SAC Relays; his wind-aided 13.69 is also fastest in the state under any conditions. Carson's Justin Collins and Colony's Khalil Dorsey are the additional threats.

In the 300-meter hurdles, Carson's Collins is the prohibitive favorite in owning three of the state's top four times, including a state-leading 36.76 at the L.A. City Section Prelims. Crenshaw's Justin Alexander, another L.A. City talent, Orange County stars Connor Meech (San Juan Hills) and Dylan Atencio (Yorba Linda), and vastly improved sophomore Aidan Christensen of Los Osos are also featured.

BOYS HORIZONTAL JUMPS

There's plenty of buzz circulating around the boys long jump pit as title contender Joey Souza of Kingsburg/CE will compete here after being 'appealed' through to his Area Finals following injury at his league final. Souza's wind-aided 25-07 from last year is tops in the field; with his school situated 25 miles from Buchanan, he's the sentimental pick for many. But Rio Mesa's Gregory Vann is the state leader this season (24-10.50), seeking to re-establish his successful mid-season form. Bakersfield's Bryce Huggins, San Diego champion Tanner Battikha (St. Augustine) and NCS three-event champ Elijah Lucy of Emery are among the additional talents on board.

While Souza aims to gain new life in the long jump after his successful appeal, teammate Seth Brooks seeks to experience déjà vu in the triple jump, where he leads the state after his 49-09.75 bound two weeks ago on this very same pit in winning the Central Section Masters Meet. Among those aiming to foil those title plans is Vista Murrieta senior C.J. Alumbres, the only 50-footer in the field (50-01.25 at last year's SS Divisional Finals) and a key cog in the Inland Empire school's team-title hopes. North Coast Section MOC

champ Ron Smith, joining Alumbres as the only returnee s from last year's final, is another notable threat.

GIRLS SPRINTS & RELAYS

An electrifying showdown should play out in the 100-meter dash, where Oaks Christian/SS sophomore Lauren Williams (who sat out her freshman campaign while attending Long Beach Poly) and Rio Mesa/SS junior Zaria Francis should lock up. When Francis has a crisp start, she is very tough to beat. Williams exhibits better strength (and thus is the clear favorite in the 200) and won their duel in the century dash last weekend, giving her a 3-1 edge over Francis in the event his spring. Mission Hills/SD speedster Suzie Acolatse has been dynamite in the deep south and seeks to swoop right on in and snag a title from the co-favorites.

The one-lap dash has taken on added intrigue in recent weeks, but hometown hero Hannah Waller remains the choice pick while owning the state's top three times, including a state-leading 53.57. Santa Rosa frosh Kirsten Carter is fresh off a lifetime-best 54.24 in winning the NCS Meet of Champions last weekend.

With Williams anchoring, Oaks Christian is the clear favorite – and #2 nationally – in the short relay while St. Mary's of Berkeley took over the state lead in the 4x400 in its last outing (3:43.97), with Roosevelt, Carondelet, and Oaks Christian a full second clear of the rest.

If Oaks Christian and Williams can avoid issues, it is the slight favorite to win the overall team title over Jasmyne Graham-led Roosevelt.

GIRLS HURDLES

Despite last year's champions in both hurdles events being non-seniors, a changing of the guard is

likely in one event and guaranteed in the other. In the 100-meter highs, USC-signed Roosevelt/SS senior Jasmyne Graham is the favorite after a truly flawless 13.21 clocking that shattered the Arcadia Invitational meet record in early April and has held the national lead in the event ever since. Defending champ Mecca McGlaston (Dublin/NC) has missed much of the season to injury, but rebounded notably to win the NCS Meet of Champions last weekend in a seasonal-best 13.72. Agoura/SS super sophomore Tara Davis (also in the horizontal jumps) and senior Mydney Mosley (Monrovia/SS) have enjoyed successful seasons as well.

The theatrics should be just as exciting in the 300-meter low hurdles, where Vacaville/SJ sophomore Jurnee Woodward blazed 41.10 last week to become the third different state leader in the event in the last six weeks. Liberty of Bakersfield super talent Morganne Hill and Roosevelt's Graham – looking for big team points for her squad – are national-caliber entries as well.

GIRLS DISTANCES

Girls distance-running fans could be afforded unmatched levels of excitement as a stellar group of four lappers (three at sub-4:44) spearhead the entry lists! Great Oak junior Destiny Collins (4:40.34 state leader) renews her clash with SS rival Amanda Gehrlich of Tesoro while Rylee Bowen of Sonoma Academy won the NCS Meet of Champions in 4:43.92, the fastest time in the nation by a freshman this spring. Palisades' Marissa Williams, who has throttled the L.A. City Section distance records this season, is an uber-tough dark horse entrant.

The road to the girls' 3200-meter

title should wind through Davis after junior Fiona O'Keeffe threw down a race for the ages in destroying the Sac-Joaquin Section Masters Meet record with a spectacular 10:00.85 triumph last weekend. Great Oak's Collins, second on the yearly state leaders list, will have a tough time doubling back from the 1600 prelims and possible final; Campolindo's Brighie Leach, Malibu's Caroline Pietrzyk, Saugus' Samantha Ortega and McKinleyville's Morgin Coonfield are among the most dangerous challengers.

The field for the 800-meter run might be the deepest we've ever seen, with a mind-boggling 18 entrants courting bests under 2:12! Two-time defending champion Mikaela Smith of Clovis North is the favorite, being unbeaten in her specialty event this spring and arriving here with fresh legs. Leading section champions Nia Akins of Rancho Bernardo/SD, Hannah Benoit of host Buchanan/CE, Ariane Arndt of St. Francis/SJ and super rising star Erica Schroeder of San Marcos/SS are the biggest threats to Smith's three-peat bid.

GIRLS THROWS

While the girls throwing events feature one of the greatest "combination" throwers in national history, she shockingly may be considered an underdog in the event where she ranks as the national leader – and an underdog to her own teammate, no less! Valley Christian of San Jose junior Elena Bruckner caught the nation by storm with a dizzying 182-foot, 8-inch toss in the discus throw at the West Catholic Athletic League Finals (CCS) to assume the national lead and move to #5 in state his-

tory in the event. However, teammate Ronna Stone has defeated her head-on in their last two meetings (including her own best of 158-10) while Newbury Park's Kendall Mader – a three-time state finalist and last year's bronze medalist – has been the most consistent of the trio this spring.

Bruckner then unleashed a monstrous 53-foot, 5.5-inch effort in winning the shot put at last week's CCS Finals, a mark which ranked tenth in national history and fifth in state history. With that, she became only the second thrower in state history to rank among the top ten all time in both events. The mark opened a wide advantage over Southland threat Nia Britt of Notre Dame/SS in the quest for the state title.

GIRLS HORIZONTAL JUMPS

The strongest field event competition of the entire weekend might play out at the long jump pit, where four of the nation's seven female 20 footers will be showcased, including the top three finishers from last year. Courtney Corrin (Harvard-Westlake/SS), the national leader at 20-11, is riding an unbeaten 2015 campaign, but just barely avoided defeat to Agoura's Tara Davis by a mere quarter of an inch at last weekend's SS Masters Meet. Redlands' Margaux Jones (20-04), the defending champion, has yet to match last year's consistency but remains a major threat while North Coast Section Meet of Champions winner Ma'ane Mosley (20-00) of St. Mary's is fresh off the best showing of her career.

The triple jump provides an equally attractive matchup, with state leader Tara Davis of Agoura (the only wind-legal 20-foot long

jump/40-foot triple jump sophomore leaper in state history) heading the entries with a 41-foot windy jump at sectionals. But North Coast Section starlets Kennedy Jones of Castro Valley and Christina Chenault of Carondelet and the Southern Section's Ciynamon Stevenson (Great Oak) are additional 40 footers in the fray.

GIRLS VERTICAL JUMPS

The lead storyline in the girls' pole vault competition centers on a former state champion seeking redemption after a crushing setback in 2014. Santa Margarita's Kaitlyn Merritt, who no-heighted while the state leader (13-09.00) at last year's SS Masters Meet, tops the charts again this season. The Stanford-signed senior owns the eight best marks statewide this season, topped with a 13-07 clearance on multiple occasions. Quick-rising sophomore Rachel Baxter (Canyon-Ana./SS), who dealt Merritt her lone loss this season, and CCS champ Erika Malaspina (Pacific Collegiate), a junior, lead the upset-minded threats.

Expect the usual nail-biting action on the girls' high jump apron, where seniors Erinn Beattie (Buena/SS) and Alexandria Florent (Harvard-Westlake/SS) each seek a fourth consecutive berth into the final. Florent is the top returnee after capturing the silver medal each of the last two years, but Beattie holds three of the state's five best marks this spring, including a state-leading 5-10 performance at the all-hands-on-deck Arcadia showdown in early April. Both Florent and Skyler Daniel (Upland/SS) have cleared 5-09.00 in 2015.
