

Lynbrook wins first SCVAL '67 baseball game

Lynbrook High School captured its first Santa Clara Athletic League varsity baseball game Wednesday by coming from behind to whip Cupertino 7-4.

The win gives Lynbrook a 1-2 record in its first season of varsity competition. The contest was a makeup of a March 14 rain out and the only SCVAL game played Wednesday.

Lynbrook pitcher Neil Swanson overcame a shaky start to finish up strong, striking out nine batters and not allowing an earned run after the second inning.

Down 3-0 in the third, the winning Vikings tied the score on a two-out triple by Jim Clark with Swanson and Bill Masella aboard, followed by a passed ball which allowed Clark to score.

In the next inning, Bob Dudley opened with a single and Bob Snyder and Masella followed with doubles to score a pair of runs, putting Lynbrook ahead to stay. Dave Anderson singled Masella home for the final run moments later.
