The Central Coast Section Last Chance meet will provide CCS athletes one last opportunity to improve qualifying marks before we head into the championship season. This will also be one of the last chances for the top Frosh-Soph boys from across CCS to compete against each other. Girls will be combined into one division but will have additional heats or larger flights. We will not offer pole vault at this meet. The Last Chance Invitational will be held at Mountain View High School this year.

Wheelchair & para ambulatory divisions will be offered at this meet in 100m, 200m, 400m and shot put. We have a shot put chair available.

Special event: Can you dip 1600m?: 1600m race only for boys who have not broken the 5 minute barrier and girls who have not broken the 6 min barrier this season. Hopefully good competition and a crowd cheering can get them there.

DATE: Saturday, April 13, 2024- Event schedule attached. Field events starting 1:00PM, track events starting at 2:00PM.

LOCATION: Mountain View High School 3535 Truman Ave. Mountain View

You can park along Truman Ave and in the church parking lot across from the track. There is some parking on Oak and Bryant, and there is a lot in the back of the school off of Bryant. Please do not park in the Blue Lake Square residential area across from the track stadium.



ENTRY INFORMATION:

All entries must be made on <u>athletic.net</u> before 9:00PM, Mon. April 8th. No updates or additions after the entry deadline. Coaches can verify accepted entries & alternates on Wednesday, April 10th on <u>www.lynbrooksports.com</u>.

- All entry marks must be recorded on athletic.net in the 2024 season. All times must be electronic. A "No Mark" (NM) will not be accepted into the meet.
- F/S boys may be entered in the Varsity division but will <u>not</u> be automatically moved to F/S if they do not meet the Varsity entry standard

EVENT ENTRY LIMITS:

The following number of entries will be accepted in each event. The top submitted times or marks in each event in Varsity Boys, F/S Boys and Girls (JV/Varsity combined) will qualify. There is no limit to the number of entries per school.

Track events up to 400m: VB 16 (2 Heats), FSB 16 (2 Heats), Girls 24 (3 heats), WC/para amb. (1 heat)

800m: VB 24 (2 heats), FSB 24 (2 heats), Girls 36 (3 heats)

1600m: VB 20 (1 heat), FSB 20 (1 heat), Girls 32 (2 heats)

Special Event: "Can you dip?" 1600m race for boys hoping to break the 5 minute barrier and girls hoping to break the 6 minute barrier. 16 entries each. Must not have achieved a mark better than 5:00 or 6:00 this season.

3200m: VB 20 (1 heat), FSB 20 (1 heat), Girls 20 (1 heat)

Relays: VB 8 teams (1 heat), FSB 8 teams (1 heat), Girls 8 teams (1 heat)

Field events: VB 20, FSB 20, Girls 20

Meet management reserves the right to adjust the field sizes to provide the best competitive atmosphere.

No Pole Vault will be contested but it will be offered in all divisions at the CCS Top 8 meet at Los Gatos High School on April 20.

ENTRY FEES: \$10.00 per event for individuals and \$20.00 per relay team. Maximum team fee \$400. All entries must be submitted on athletic.net. You will be charged for all entries that are accepted. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATHLETES:

- An alternate list will be posted the week of the meet with live updates as scratches occur. Alternates should check in with the clerk and will be added whenever possible. They should show up at the start of the event in case of very last-minute scratches. Please email any scratches you become aware of before meet day to Jonathan Hubbs (coachhubbs@gmail.com)
- A warm-up area is available on the grass and turf fields next to the track stadium.
- All Running Events Fast Heat First. Lane assignments will be seeded by best times and marks. No bibs needed for laned events. Hip numbers will be worn for 1600, 800, 3200, and 4x400 relay
- All track athletes must check in at least 20 minutes prior to the event at the clerk tent on the infield. Hip numbers will be given out there for distance events & 4x4
- All field athletes must check in no later than 20 min. prior to the start of the event with the official, even if in flight 2. Flights seeded by best marks. Best marks in flight 2.
- All field event athletes get 4 attempts.
- Implement Weigh-ins will begin at 12:00PM near the shot put area. Implements not making weight will be held until after the event is completed.
- Opening height for HJ will be: VB 5'2", FSB 4'8", VG 4'2"
- Athletes doing a field event and running event at the same time, must tell the field judge when leaving and returning. If not, and their turn is up, they will scratch that attempt. Telling the judge, will allow making up the attempt only if the flight, height, or event is not over.
- Track events will run up to 10 minutes early
- No headphones/electronics or food will be allowed on the infield or track.
- Only coaches and athletes preparing for events should be in the infield area.
- All CIF uniform rules will be enforced.
- There are no dressing rooms or shower facilities. Please come prepared to compete.
- An EMT is available in the tent in the middle of the field.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Award medals to top 3 placings in each event
- Scoring is 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

- Admission fee: adults \$8, seniors & students \$5, children 12 & under free. Tickets must be purchased on GoFan beforehand or at the gate. Cash will not be accepted. <u>Click here for the link to purchase tickets</u>.
