SCVAL CHAMPIONSHIP PROPOSAL

Pros	Cons
Having all 15 schools together creates a more competitive meet for our athletes.	There's something nice about going against only the schools in our division. This proposal changes this dynamic.
These are qualifier meets. Having the DAL and ECL meets at different sites on different days creates conditions that could be favorable to one league and detrimental to another (wind, weather, track conditions, etc.). Bringing everyone together makes competition fair.	No trials for JV
All 15 schools can help work all of the events. Remember that our coaches have to work the field events and manage the meet. It's much more manageable to divide between 15 schools instead of 7 or 8.	
Starters are hard to find, and this proposal means we need a starter for 3 meets instead of 5.	
The current meet schedule is hard for our athletes: one day in between trials and finals, then going to the SCVAL meet the next week. This proposal has about 10 days in between the meet, decreasing the chance of injury. We have had some athletes who jog at the finals just to complete it because they are not 100% healthy after trials.	
Having one day and one meet dedicated to JV is more special for that group.	
More flexibility for rescheduling due to bad weather	
Spreading out the events and having fewer events during the week means less school time is missed.

I don't completely get the new alignment? I would prefer based on dual meets since with a big combined event, schools may not get enough qualifiers in, so a school that does well enough going 1-1, may not do as well if a few people don't make it to finals because their time is behind a bunch of others. Also it encourages schools to have their kids run in the school meets and not sit out meets for invites.

Suggestions and Ideas	Responses
Do the 4x800 on the trials day.	
The proposal should explicitly say that the JV meet will be seeded, but winners can come from any heat.	
Consider allowing other schools besides Santa Clara, Los Gatos, and MacDonald to host these meets. Pole vault can be conducted at a site with the facility the day before, if needed. Or we can do all pole vault events on finals day at a site that has it, and the trials meet can rotate between the other schools in the league.	
Consider allowing schools to enter as many as they want per event, but only guarantee 2 or 3 per school. Then fill the event with any remaining open spots with the next best marks.

I also brought up the idea to him about dividing SCVAL into 3 equal leagues of 5 for an A, B, C structure. Here's an easy fix: add interleague meets and scrimmages to the schedule that do not count toward final standings.
