Dear CCS Track & Field Committee,

Note: The CCS Office is still working to confirm the contact information of the head Track & Field coaches for 2025. To insure they receive this information, please share this email with your league colleagues.

As we begin the competition season for Track & Field, here are some updates:

- As per the CCS Calendar, **this week** (February 17-22) is the first week where scrimmages can be conducted. Non-scoring scrimmage meets can be conducted in which the results are not publicly published and no marks recorded can be used for entry into other competitions. **Next week** (February 24-March 1) is the first week for normal competition. *Please note: although some other Sections in California may have earlier starting dates and may be conducting meets this week, as CCS member schools, we are subject to CCS Bylaws and, therefore, cannot participate prior to February 24th.*
- At their last meeting the CCS Board of Managers approved the CCS Track & Field Committee proposal which included the provisions for semifinals in the 4x800 for 2025. Therefore each league will be able to forward the number of entries in the 4x800 to the CCS Semifinals that they are allotted in every other event. However, for 2025, there will not be an at-large time for the 4x800 to the CCS Semis because there is not yet 3 years of data available to establish that standard (as required by the CCS Track & Field Bylaws).
- Because of the addition of the 4x800 to the CCS Semifinals, at the recommendation of your Committee, we will begin the track events one hours earlier than the last few years (10:00 am) and the 4x800 will be conducted prior to the 3200m semifinals. To minimize athlete conflicts between the long jumps and the 4x100 relay, we will begin the long jumps one-half hour earlier than in the past few years (9:30 am).
