12 Teams Compete in Midwest Regionals Despite Inclement Weather

The Midwest Corporate Athletic Association Corporate Cup Relays, held in the Detroit suburb of Sterling Heights, has had a history of variable weather conditions over the last seven years. Experiencing everything from high heat to cold wind, this year was no exception. Although Michigan weather had been very good this year, and even though conditions were ideal for the 10K and 5K runs and race walk in the morning, the skies opened up for the afternoon track events giving a cold, often heavy, rain.

Nevertheless, 12 teams were in contention throughout the event, June 22.

In Division I, the strong team from General Electric avenged last year's loss to Cadillac Motor Division of GM by scoring 244 points to Cadillac's 221. Cadillac had started the day out with wins in the women's 10K and men's 5K runs and walk, while Chrysler won both the men's 10K and women's 5K runs.

General Electric, however, showed its overwhelming power on the track by winning 11 of the 13

events. Chrysler completed the day in third place with 194 points, and Ford Motor Company rounded out the division with 111 points in fourth.

The Division II contest was a "threespeat" performance by the team from Parke-Davis Pharmaceutical Research, which previously won the division in 1989 and 1990. Having won all the 10K and 5K distance competitions in the morning, the team scored either first or second in 9 of the remaining 10 events on the track to tally 186 points.

Second place was decided by 4 points as the Saturn Division of GM edged out National Steel's "A team" by a 147 to 143 score. The remaining teams in order of finish were: National Steel "B Team" -- 76; Digital Equipment -- 55; Perrigo Corporation -- 49; Parke-Davis "B Team" -- 42; National Steel "C Team" -- 14; Crescive Tool & Die -- 12.

The MWCAA encourages other corporate teams from the states of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio and Wisconsin to compete in this midwest regional meet in June, 1992. Interested teams should contact Geoff Lane at
