Congratulations team, for your strong performance in the winter relays. When the smoke had cleared we finished in second place, six points behind Lockheed, 67-61. The most encouraging aspect of the meet was the strong performances turned in by the newcomers to the track team. Lloyd Johnson ran a 4:16.4 mile, fastest time ever turned in by an HPer. Additionally, Micki Tutush, 64.5 in the 440, Lucy Rempel, 27.4 in the 220 and 68.2 in the 440, and Reggie Green, 51.1 in the 440 ran well for a early season meet. Veterans also turned in some notable performances: Hank Lawson ran a 3:16.4 1320 in the Pyramid, Ollie Polk ran a 25.5, 220, Virgil Torrence ran two, 23.2, 220s, and the Senior's Relay Team of Bert Frescura, Marj Moore, and Bob Lewis ran the 2nd fastest time ever recorded in their event, 3:33.46. Congratulations again, and I'm sure I'll see you in the spring.
