8th Annual Winter Corporate Relays

It was record day on Feb 24th, in terms of the weather, times run and teams participating. The weather was a beautiful and clear 75 degrees (spring fever was in the air). Two teams broke a 3 year old meet record in the Coed/Master Mile Team Race, thus earning themselves the coveted "free pitcher of beer", and we had 10 complete teams and 2 partial teams all going for the perpetual trophy.

The day started off with a non-scoring 2.6 mile Cross-Country run open to team members and families alike. It was won by D Callendce of Sun Microsystems in 16:08 and Kristen Wilde of Chevron in 17:54. We then moved to the track where the competition really got hot with perennial powers Hewlett-Packard and Lockheed fighting off surprise teams of General Electric and Syntex. The lead changed 3 times throughout the day with battles also being close for 2nd, 3rd and 4th place. When the tarps came down and the warriors retreated to the pizza parlour for the awards and the days video, we saw HP repeating as champion with 78 points, surprise team GE taking 2nd with 67 points and powerhouse Lockheed just hanging on for 3rd over Syntex with 59 Vs 56 points. Rounding out the finishing teams were Pac*Tel, SRI, Sun Micro, Chevron, Nat'l Semi, AT&T, Max/Mips and Lockheed B. We also held the first annual Korporate Kids Run, a 440 yard dash for any child that wanted to participate. Other than the few tears from the younger participants who were unable to keep up with their older sibblings, it was well received. The day ended with a remark from a Chevron runner saying, "Now I know that I'm a year older".
