1981 Corporate Cup Relays National Indoor Championships

The first event of the 1981 Corporate Cup Relays & Road Races will be the National Indoor Championships. Competition will be spread over the two days, as outlined below:

Trials: To be at Stanford Stadium, located on the Stanford University Campus in Palo Alto on January 1, 1981.

Facilities: Restrooms, changing facilities. Track is all-weather ($\frac{1}{2}$ " spikes or flats)

Finals: To be held in conjunction with the Runner's World Indoor Classic on the evening of January 2, 1981 at the Cow Palace in San Francisco.

Events-(distances for trials)

Men's Mile Team Race: Two male runners with their times totaled for scoring purposes.

Women's Relay: Three women running legs $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, in that order.

Master's Relay: Three runners, 40 years or older, running legs of $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, in that order.

Men's 3000 M Team Race: Two male runners with their times totaled for scoring purposes.

Indoor Pyramid Relay: Five runners, at least two of them female, running legs of $\frac{1}{8}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{8}$ mile, in that order.

The trial will qualify 6 teams to the finals except for the Indoor Pyramid Relay, which will qualify 12 teams to a two-heat final. The finals will be run on a 160 yard, banked track ($\frac{1}{2}$ " spikes or flats only). Due to the size of the we will alter the distances slightly as follows:

Women's Relay: 3 laps, 5 laps, 3 laps
Master's Relay: 5 laps, 3 laps, 5 laps
Pyramid Relay: 1 lap, 3 laps, 5 laps, 3 laps, 1 lap

Scoring

1st place - 8 points	4th place - 3 points
2nd place - 6 points	5th place - 2 points
3rd place - 4 points	6th place - 1 point
Participating and finishing an event (places 7th on down) - 1 point	

Awards

Medals to first three teams per event. Team trophies to top three teams and other prizes.

Divisions

Class AA, Class A and Class B will all compete together this first year of indoor competition.

! Some good times were Ulrich Kaempf (50) 33:03 for 10K, Mary Jo
! Blankenship (40+) 52:03 for 10K (womens). Ed Harris & Mike
! Bush ran 53.0 for 440 yds and Hank Lawson ran 2:05 for 880.
! Barb Briseno ran a 2:58 for a 880, all done indoors. We then went
! on to run the Natural Lite Half Marathon on Feb 22nd. The top
! 5 runners made up the team. Our place and time spread was first
! man at 20th (1:14:23), 5th man at 160 (1:37:10). Our team time
! was 7:14:49 a 1:26:58 ave per man. Those times were good enough
! to take 1st place, beating Westinghouse who was 2nd. We are now
! preparing for the CCA 10K & 20K Road Race Championships to be held
! in Santa Rosa on March 28th. We should be able to do quite well.
! Next will come the Regionals at the end of June then the Nationals
! sometime in July.

! Second, I would like to know who is interested in receiving
! these memos. Even if you do not plan on coming out here to run for
! us, I would still like to keep you informed. If you have no interest
