LOCATION: El Camino High School
4300 El Camino Avenue
Sacramento 21, California

HOW TO GET THERE: Take Highway 40 Freeway out of Sacramento toward Roseville.
Turn right on El Camino Avenue and follow it for 3 miles.
El Camino High School is on your right after you cross
Eastern Avenue.

LENGTH OF RACE: 1.83 miles
Track shoes may be worn. The course is composed of cinders,
crushed granite, and grass -- no pavement.

QUALIFIERS: The 1st and 2nd place teams in each section will qualify,
also the top three boys from each section, whether they are
on a qualifying team or not.
Each school may enter seven (7) men. The low score of the
first 5 boys determines the winner.

ENTRIES: Individual names should be sent to El Camino High School
no later than November 27, 1956, so numbers can be assigned
before the meet.

AWARDS: 20 ribbons will be awarded for the first 20 finishes.
First, second and third place team trophies will also
be awarded.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. The awards assembly will be held immediately following
the meet in the school cafeteria.
2. The meet will be photographed.
3. Refreshments will be furnished after the awards
assembly by the El Camino Eaglesmen.
