# Impressive Showing By Carlmont Harriers

STANFORD — A record 1,089 runners competed yesterday in the weekly high school cross country center meet on the Stanford Golf Course, with Carlmont coming up with the best team showing.

The collapse and death of Buchser High School athlete, Ken Lapka, 14, in one of the freshman heats (See story on Page 2), marred what otherwise had been the biggest day in Northern California prep cross country history.

The previous center meet record for competitors was under 900.

Although the Scots placed no man higher than seventh in their heat, their cumulative team time of 51:36 was 17 seconds better than runnerup Cubberley.

And the mark was nearly a full minute better than the Scots' 52:30 at this time in the 1960 season when they emerged as the top team in NorCal prep ranks.

Top Scots yesterday were sophomores Ken Nichols (10:12) and Mike McCann (10:13) and junior Jack Sandin (10:13), who finished seventh, eighth and ninth, respectively.

Carlmont's junior varsity was second in its heat and second in the over-all standings in that division, and the Scot sophomores were the same. Carlmont's freshman team was first.

# Carlmont Leads SPAL Sweep

STANFORD — Carlmont, running in its usual form, paved the way for a South Peninsula sweep of all four divisions yesterday at the second Center Meet of the cross country season on the Stanford Golf Course.

Loren Lansberry's Scots ran the 2.0 mile course in a varsity team time of 50 minutes, 13 seconds. The individual winner was Mike Ryan of Wilcox who shaved a tenth of a second off the course record he set last year. Ryan circled the course in 9:30.6.

Cubberley copped junior varsity honors over Woodside by two minutes, running the course in 54 minutes, 29 seconds. San Carlos took sophomore and freshman divisions in team times of 54 minutes, 56 seconds and 56 minutes, 39 seconds, respectively.

Lansberry's Scots clipped 39 seconds off their team time of

last week on the same course. Conditions were described as excellent on the course this week by Jim Luttrell, the meet director.

That factor may have accounted for the lowering of times this week, but Luttrell classed all schools in the varsity sophomore and freshman heats according to strength to distribute competition evenly. Thus all the varsity powerhouses attending the meet ran in the third varsity heat.

In all 661 runners from 29 high schools competed.

# Schoolboy Succumbs In Race

STANFORD — A 14-year-old Santa Clara schoolboy died after collapsing near the end of a two-mile cross country race at the Stanford Golf Course yesterday afternoon.

Kenneth Lapka, son of Mr. and Mrs. Kenneth Lapka of 654 Hamilton Drive, Santa Clara, was pronounced dead on arrival at Palo Alto-Stanford Hospital Center at 5:15 p.m., shortly after he collapsed.

The hospital's emergency room staff failed in a three-hour effort to revive the youth by applying external heart massage and artificial respiration.

Hospital officials said they haven't "the slightest idea" why the boy collapsed. The Santa Clara County coroner's office had scheduled an autopsy this afternoon to determine the cause of death.

The youth, a freshman at Buchser High School in Santa Clara, was one of 1,114 high school runners from 57 schools competing in the Stanford Center Cross Country Meet.

Race officials said everyone in the youth's pre-final heat had crossed the finish line and another race had been started when the boy collapsed about 40 yards short of the finish line.

The boy's coach, Pat Penick, rushed him to the nearby hospital.

Penick said he believes the youth was alive during the trip to the hospital. He said he applied mouth-to-mouth resuscitation in an attempt to revive the stricken boy.

Rosary will be recited at 8:30 p.m. Sunday at the Harmon A. Smith Funeral Home, Santa Clara, and a low mass will be sung at 9 a.m. Monday at St. Justin's Church, Santa Clara.

Interment will be in Santa Clara Catholic Cemetery.

Kenneth was the brother of David, James, Marilyn, Joy and Bryan Lapka.

He also is survived by his grandparents in South Dakota.
