

Center Meet:

Carlmont Cleans Up In Cross Country

STANFORD — The second largest turnout in history gathered yesterday at the Stanford Golf Course for the first Center Meet of the 1963 high school cross country season.

Carlmont swept varsity honors with 28 minutes, running the two mile course in a team time of 50 minutes and 52 seconds.

In all 969 runners competed yesterday in four divisions.

Carlmont's Martin McCann and Bill Bradfield turned in the best times by area runners. Both ran 9:59 and finished one-two, respectively, in their heat.

Cubberley walked off with jayvee honors, rounding out SPAL dominance of the meet. Logan and Central Junior won the sophomore and freshman events, respectively.

The largest group to run at Stanford was 1089 last year, and meet director Jim Luttrell of San Carlos expects well over 1,000 runners for next Thursday's second meet.

Scots Blitz Two Records

STANFORD — The list of broken records was long and the number of cross country runners was large yesterday on the two mile Stanford Golf Course layout.

Carlmont turned in a team time of 49 minutes, 27 seconds, a second slower than the field record set by Washington High of Fremont in 1960.

But the Scot time was good for a new school record and the best time by an SPAL team ever run on the course. Both old marks were set by the 1961 Carlmont squad at 50 minutes, 16 seconds.

Mike McCann snapped a Carlmont school record with his 9:38 clocking. The old mark was Dave Kamrar's 9:49 in 1960, and Bill Bradfield turned in the best time ever by a Carlmont sophomore.

He ran a 9:47, surpassing Kamrar's old school mark, and bettered Grant Long's 9:49.3 as the best soph time.

Oh, by the way Carlmont won the varsity race, racking up 30 points. Closest high school opponent was Mills' 54 tallies. In addition to winning the meet, the Scots topped the San Jose State frosh team 40-98. And Cubberley ran over the Stanford frosh 21-36.

The center meet hosted the largest number of runners in its history yesterday. In all 1,101 runners competed.

Cupertino, San Mateo and Central Junior High won the junior varsity, sophomore and freshman events, respectively.

Carlmont Leads SPAL Sweep

STANFORD — Carlmont, running in its usual form, paved the way for a South Peninsula sweep of all four divisions yesterday at the second Center Meet of the cross country season on the Stanford Golf Course.

Loren Lansberry's Scots ran the 2.0 mile course in a varsity team time of 50 minutes, 13 seconds. The individual winner was Mike Ryan of Wilcox who shaved a tenth of a second off the course record he set last year. Ryan circled the course in 9:30.6.

Cubberley copped junior varsity honors over Woodside by two minutes, running the course in 54 minutes, 29 seconds. San Carlos took sophomore and freshman divisions in team times of 54 minutes, 56 seconds and 56 minutes, 39 seconds, respectively.

Lansberry's Scots clipped 39 seconds off their team time of

last week on the same course. Conditions were described as excellent on the course this week by Jim Luttrell, the meet director.

That factor may have accounted for the lowering of times this week, but Luttrell classed all schools in the varsity sophomore and freshman heats according to strength to distribute competition evenly. Thus all the varsity powerhouses attending the meet ran in the third varsity heat.

In all 661 runners from 29 high schools competed.
