

Ryan Wins It:

# Scots Set School Mark

BELMONT—Carlmont High's cross country team set a school record and soothed its wounded pride here yesterday in the final event of the season, a five-man, 10-mile team race with some of the best prep teams in the nation.

Carlmont's five runners, four whom were ailing with a virus the past week, clocked an aggregate time of 48:21.7 to cut their own school mark by six-tenths of a second and defeat the two teams that spoiled an otherwise perfect season, Wilcox of Santa Clara and Homestead of Sunnyvale.

Six of the top 13-ranked prep harrier teams in the nation competed Friday, but host Carlmont was the only one to better its time in the rain and cold.

Mike Ryan of Wilcox, the top-ranked prep two-miler in the

U.S. this fall, won individual honors easily with a time of 8:58.9, 1.2 seconds off his second - best - U.S. - prep - of - all-time clocking of 8:57.7 last month.

Carlmont twins Mike and Martin McCann followed in 9:24.4 and 9:31.3, both marks slower than previous efforts.

Wilcox' No. 2 runner, John Henry, became ill during the race and finished last on his own squad, which ruined the Warriors' chances to repeat their time - victory over Carlmont last month.

Wilcox finished second and homestead, which upset Carlmont in the North Coast Section champion race last week, was third.

Carlmont, which had beaten Wilcox in point scoring in their

earlier duel, won by a wider margin, 35-60, Friday.

# Carlmont Harriers Hold No. 3 Ranking

BELMONT — Carlmont's school record effort in the five-man, 10-mile race here Friday did not improve the Scots' third place standing in current national high school rankings.

Coach Loren Lansberry received the latest information on the postal competition just before his Scots shaved six-tenths of a second off their previous mark with an impressive 48:21.7 aggregate in the rain.

West High of Proviso, Ill., continues to lead the U.S. with its record effort of 48:05.9. Wilcox High of Santa Clara, which Carlmont defeated soundly Friday, still holds second place with its 48:20.7 clocking last month.

Seven of the top 13 teams in the rankings are from the Bay Area, four of those from the Peninsula and Santa Clara Valley.

Mike Ryan of Wilcox, second-ranking U.S. prep two miler of all-time, failed to better his top 1964 ranking time of 8:57.7 Friday, running 8:58.9.

Latest information shows that Jim Ryun, the sub-four minute miler from East High in Wichita,

Kan., has displaced Carlmont's Mike McCann as No. 2 in the nation. Ryun's time of 9:10 must be verified, however, since there was a report that it was clocked on a cross country course instead of a track as is required.

Carlmont junior Tom Wake cracked the national two-mile rankings Friday with a time of 9:40, good for 14th place.
