Stanford runners nabbed five of the top 10 places Saturday to pace the Indians to the open division title in the annual Sacramento State invitational cross country meet.

Stanford scored 25 points, followed by the University of California at 96, University of Nevada at Reno with 109, Chico State at 115, San Diego State with 132.

Gary Tuttle, former Chico State runner now competing for the Southern California Striders, won the 4.2-mile open race in 21 minutes and 45 seconds.

Bob Walden of Cal was second, followed by Bob Coe of Stanford; Athol Botton of Nevada; Forrest Brock, Chuck Mens, Don Kardong and Arvid Kietz, all of Stanford; Cliff Clark of the Air Force and Steve Dean of Sacramento State.

Tom Lipshi paced Santa Ana to victory in the junior college division by running the 4.2 miles in 22:56.

Mira Loma High School of Sacramento took the high school team trophy and Chuck Mork of Washington High in Fremont was the individual winner at 16:01 for 2.6 miles.

More than 800 runners competed in seven divisions.

Stanford's next meet will be this Saturday against USC at Los Angeles.

The Stanford varsity opened the '69 competitive season with an impressive display of team depth as the Indians won the Open-University Division of the Sacramento State Invitational for the second straight year. California was a surprise second in the team race. Sophomore Robert Coe led the Tribe with a 3rd place finish behind Gary Tuttle (Striders) and Bob Waldon (Cal). Five Stanford runners finished in the top ten with Greg Brock (5th), Chuck Menz (6th), Don Kardong (7th), and Arvid Kretz (9th). Freshman Decker Underwood finished an impressive 13th, and Jack Lawson 18th in the 100 plus field of runners. Chuck Dyer (8th) was a medal winner in the Frosh-JC race. SC was idle in cross country over the weekend and will host the Indians next Saturday on the Long Beach State course.
