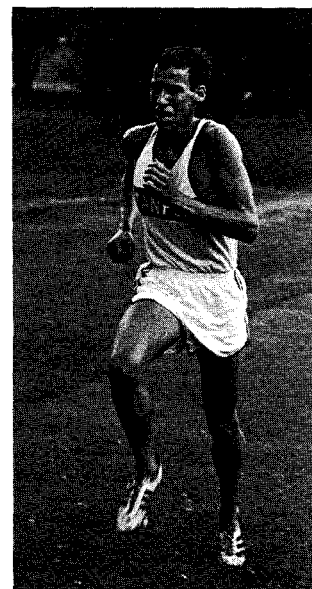

CROSS COUNTRY, WATER POLO, SOCCER PREVIEWS

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MARSHALL L. CLARK, HEAD CROSS COUNTRY COACH

Met with instant success last season in his first year at Stanford, guiding the Indian cross country team to its finest campaign ever...Coached the Tribe harriers through an undefeated dual meet season and into the NCAA meet, where they finished second behind defending champion Villanova...Turned out the first two Stanford cross country All-Americans since 1964--Greg Brock and Brook Thomas... Graduate of U.S.C. in 1957...Lettered in track and cross country for three years... Compiled a 10-year coaching record of 79-18 in cross country and 56-31-1 in track, while at Los Altos High School in La Puente and Seaside High School in Monterey.

SEASON OUTLOOK

The 1969 Stanford cross country season should be highly competitive, with Pacific-8 conference schools again fielding the top teams in NCAA competition. A new feature this year will be the Pac-8 championship meet, to be held at Stanford on November 15.

The Indians will have four lettermen returning from last year's undefeated dual meet team which placed second in the NCAA finals--senior co-captains Greg Brock and Chuck Menz, and juniors Don Kardong and Duncan Macdonald. Brock was an All-American in 1968 along with now departed teammate Brook Thomas. Senior Steve Jones, another experienced varsity competitor from the '68 squad, also returns this fall.

With several outstanding sophomore candidates, plus a fine crop of freshmen who will be eligible for varsity competition this year, the seven varsity positions will be wide open. Prime sophomore prospects are frosh mile record-holder Bob Coe, Arvid Kretz, Jack Lawson, George Watson, Bruce McCormach, and Dave Whiteing. The talented group of incoming frosh includes California State mile champion Decker Underwood, Brian Mittelstaedt, Charles Dyer, Leo Tirado, and Rick Geisler.

Thomas, who still has one year of track eligibility remaining, was not the only letterman lost from last year's team. Allen Sanford and Bob Anchondo have also departed, leaving holes to be filled by upcoming sophs and freshmen.
