Mork ties for top NorCal harrier award

Washington's Chuck Mork shared the honor of Runner of the Year and along with Campolindo's Tom Hale and Sunset's Ron Genschmer was named to the 22-man all-Northern California Cross Country Team released yesterday.

Ygnacio Valley's Jim Anderson, Bob Grubbs of Washington and Mike Knott of Mt. Diablo were also selected to the first team.

Mork shared the top runner award with Willow Glen's Mike Hart and Carlmont's Hans Templeman. He went undefeated against Eastbay competition in 1970 and won the Mission Valley Athletic League, North Coast Section Division I and section titles.

It marked the third time that Hale was selected to the team and it was an encouraging finish to a somewhat disappointing season for the Campolindo senior.

Hale was out for nearly a month with shin splints but came back to capture the Foothill Athletic League crown and placed fifth in the North Coast Section Division II and 10th in the section.

Genschmer won the Hayward Area Athletic League title and came in eighth in the section final. His only losses this year were to Mork in the Modesto Invitational and NCS Division I.
