Templeman Tops SPAL Harriers

Hans Templeman and Carlmont High, not surprisingly, dominate the 1970 All-South Peninsula Athletic League cross country team picked by the league coaches.

Templeman was named the cross country Runner of the Year for the second straight time to pace a six-man delegation from league champion Carlmont on the 12-man first

In addition to the varsity, the coaches picked all-league teams for the sophomore and freshman divisions. All three divisions included honorable mention lists.

Several criteria were used in selecting the squads, including finish in the SPAL and Central Coast Section race and

times for the two-mile, Golden Gate Park and Covote Park courses.

Templeman was easily the league standout by every measure. He won the Central Coast Section race, the SPAL race and posted the league's best times for two miles (9:14.0), Golden Gate Park (11:54.0) and Covote Park (12:50.0).

Carlmont's Steve Miller, only a sophomore wasn't far behind Templeman in most cases and was named Outstanding Sophomore. Two other sophomores made firstteam varsity all-league, Carl Cattarin of Carlmont and Gordan MacMitchell of Gunn.

Carlmont's Russ Black, a first-team varsity choice, was named Outstanding Junior and Kelly Lawson of San Carlos was tabbed the Outstanding Freshman.

Templeman and San Carlos' Bryan Geiser made first team varsity for the third consecutive year, while Carlmont senior Scott Carvey was a twoyear first-team choice.

Black and Chuck Oliver of Carlmont, Ken White of San Carlos and John Barbour of Menlo-Atherton all made firstteam varsity this season after earning first team sophomore berths last year.

Other first-team varsity choices are Pete Marks of Woodside and Mike Basham of San Carlos.
