

CIF Harriers Run At LB State Today

Only two-miles away from the CIF championships, Orange County's 13 representatives compete in the semi-finals today at Long Beach State.

The first five teams in each of today's eight two-mile races will advance to next week's finals. The first three runners who are among the top five finishers in their race will also qualify for the finals.

Angelus League champion Mater Dei and Sonora, Orange League winner, are the first county teams to run, competing in the 10:40 race. Valencia runs in the second 2-A race at 11.

Alamitos are entered in the first 3-A race which starts at 11:20. In the second 3-A event will be El Modena, Fullerton, and Garden Grove.

Running in the first 4-A race at noon will be Santa Ana Valley and Newport Harbor. Costa Mesa and Marina are entered in the second event at 12:20.
