Carlmont Harriers Win Center Meet

SAN JOSE — Carlmont High won its second straight cross-country Center Meet Thursday afternoon at Coyote Park here as Scot sophomore Steve Miller came within 100 yards of beating favored teammate Hans Templeman.

Templeman and Miller each broke the course record of 13:16 easily, as Carlmont set a course record on the hilly 2.65 mile course.

All the SPAL schools competed except for San Carlos, which was minus three of its top runners, Matt Yeo (shin splints), Mike Basham (cold) and Jim Richter (cold).

Sequoia turned in the most surprising performance by picking up fifth place. Woodside was eighth, Gunn ninth and Cubberley 10th. Menlo-Atherton and Palo Alto did not field complete teams.

Results of junior varsity, sophomore and freshman races were not available.

Carlmont placed its top five runners (the point-getters) in the top ten. After Templeman and Miller came Scott Carvey (fourth), Carl Cattarin (fifth) and Chuck Oliver (10th).

Other SPAL placers in the top twenty included Carlmont's "other man," Russ Black (11th), Sequoia's Noe Vigil (13th), Pete Marks of Woodside (17th) and Cherokee Greg Patrick (19th).

Two center meets, one at Coyote Park and the other at Golden Gate Park in San Francisco, will be held Thursday with all of the SPAL teams running in one or the other.
