

Devils picked to win DVAL cross-country

The 7th annual Diablo Valley Athletic League Invitational cross country meet will be held today at Clayton Valley High School in Concord.

Mt. Diablo, last year's champion, is one of the favorites to capture this year's title along with last year's runner-up, Pleasant Hill.

Ygnacio Valley High, which won the event in 1967 and 1968 will also be on hand as a strong contender along with Riordan and Pittsburg High.

The frosh-soph reserve race will open the day's events at 10 a.m. with the regular frosh-soph, junior varsity and varsity races set to get underway at around 11:15 a.m.

The varsity race is a three-mile affair while all other races are two and a half miles.
