SAN FRANCISCO — Every cross country team should be so "mediocre" as the Carlmont High Scots were Thursday in the final center meet of the season at Golden Gate Park.

"We didn't do as well as we could," coach Loren Lansberry observed after the meet in which the Scots set a new course record and senior Hans Templeman added one more record to his already long list.
