

# M-A Harriers Finish Third

Menlo-Atherton's varsity cross-country team finished third among six schools last Monday on the M-A course behind a strong showing by Doug Yost and John Barbour.

This coming Monday M-A will host Sequoia, Palo Alto, Buchser, Terra Nova and El Camino at 3:15.

Coach Plato Yanicks was pleased with both his star players performances. The team is hurting from injuries to captain Dan Meub and Earl Meneweather.

Yanicks was also happy with Art Middel's showing in the junior varsity race. Bob Shibata ended up third in the junior race and Dan Lewis was fifth.

Due to these fine positions Menlo-Atherton took the Junior varsity team totals.

The Freshmen placed third in their race which was 440 yard shorter than the varsity's or the junior varsity's.

The Varsity's record is now three wins and six losses. The number of defeats is already more than any other Menlo-Atherton harrier squad since Yanicks started the sport in 1965.
