M-A Harriers Luck Terrible

Even with two runners in the top 12 finishers, Menlo-Atherton's cross-country squad placed fourth in a 5-way meet with Terra Nova, Sequoia, El Camino and Palo Alto last Monday on M-A's 2.2 mile course.

"It was the worst performance by a Menlo-Atherton team in the school's history," said coach Plato Yanick. "I never have seen an M-A team look so bad."

The squad has talent but it's just not performing up to its capacity according to Yanicks.

The Palo Alto high graduate also said, "We've had a lot of tough luck this year, every week it's something, either Meneweather (Earl — appendicitis) or Kringle (Rich — sick last meet)."

But not all bad came from Monday's meet.

"John Barbour's fourth place finish was our lone bright spot," said Yanicks. His time of 10:49.5 was the fastest ever recorded for an M-A junior. Also, it ranked next to Dan Britts as the second best time for an M-A runner on their home course.

Senior Doug Yost placed twelfth with an 11:19 clocking.

The Junior Varsity also finished low in their team standings, third out of four schools.

Yanicks feels his freshman team is the best he's coached

since the 1966 team.

Pete Jones, who Yanicks says, "has improved greatly," and Neal Penney finished second and third respectively for M-A.

The freshmen only run 1.9 miles.
