

Fast time for Terman runner

Jerry Emory, a 13-year-old eighth grader at Terman Junior High School, turned in one of the best times in the nation for the two-mile run when he covered the distance in 10:51.1.

He was competing in a national postal meet at Terman Tuesday. His time will be compared with that of other runners across the nation and probably will rank in the top 10.

In varsity competition, Woodside High School had a time of

53:41 to beat out Menlo-Atherton which was clocked in 54:04.8.

A Bad Day For Bear C-C Teams

Every coach has a bad day, but no coach deserves to have the kind of day that Plato Yanicks, Menlo-Atherton High cross country coach, was subjected to Tuesday.

Yanicks scheduled a cross country postal meet at Menlo College, and should have quit when only two full teams (Woodside and his own) showed up to compete. But he didn't.

And that was another bad break.

M-A's varsity team would have won the meet had it been a regular dual meet, but this was a postal, in which team time, not places, decide the winner. Woodside, picking up support from frosh runner Bruce Poole, beat the Bears by 23 seconds.

In a postal meet, the times of a school's top five finishers, with runners from all divisions contributing, are tallied for a final team time. Poole's time of 11:10 over the two-mile rubber asphalt track was better than the fifth man on Woodside's varsity, and it was enough to pull the Cats to a win.

Yanicks' freshman team would have won its race also, except for the postal scoring system.

The little Bears tallied 40 points, while Woodside and Terman Junior High each had 43, but Terman's team time was 15 seconds better than M-A's.
