

Scot Harriers Equal a Record

SAN JOSE — Carlmont High's varsity cross-country team added another trophy to its long list Saturday when the Scots won what coach Loren Lansberry called "probably the most competitive postal meet ever run in prep history" Saturday on San Jose State's all-weather track.

The Scots tied the San Mateo County record team time of 47:43.2 set in 1968 by Burlingame and also tied the second fastest time in national prep postal meet history. The record of 47:11.2 was set by Homestead in 1968.

However, Scot ace Hans Templeman failed to cross the finish line first for the only time this season. He turned in a creditable 9:14.0 clocking for the two-mile run, third behind Willow Glen's Mike Hart (9:10.0) and Washington's Chuck Mork (9:13.5).

Lansberry praised Scot sophomore Steve Miller for "probably the finest effort by a sophomore in postal history" for a 9:18.2 clocking and fourth-place finish.

The results of postal meets are sent to Track and Field News in Los Altos and tabulated along with results of similar postal meets throughout the nation. At the end of the season, Track and Field News publishes a national high school ranking.

Russ Black, Scott Carvey and Carl Cattarin completed Carlmont's scoring team. Lansberry noted that Carlmont's time was the fastest known in the nation this year.

San Carlos High, led by Mike Basham, was the only other SPAL team entered and finished 11th in team time scoring. The Dons' Kelly Lawson, running in varsity competition, notched the day's best freshman time at 10:08.0.

Carlmont finished second and San Carlos sixth in sophomore competition, while San Carlos was third and Carlmont fifth in the freshman division.
