4 National Titles

Redwood City Strider runners won two national team titles and two national individual titles this season according to the final results of AAU age-group postal meet results.

The Striders successfully defended their national titles in the 10-11 and 12-13 age groups, while Striders Dave Cortez (12-13) and Mitch Kingery (14-15) garnered individual titles.

Postal meets are held on a flat track over a specified distance, with the results compiled on a national basis. Thirteen states submitted times this year.

Cortez led the Striders 12-13 squad to the team title with a 10:36.6 clocking for two miles. A team time is compiled by adding the two-mile times of a squad's five fastest runners. The Striders' team time in the 12-13 group was 57:53.6.

Strider teammate Rick Volk was second nationally behind Cortez with an 11:19.0 clocking. The times of Cortez and Volk are both better than the listed national record for 12 year olds.

Sam Monaco led the Striders to the team title in the 10-11 division by placing third best in the nation for one-mile with a 5:33.6 clocking.

Vance Eberly of San Jose had the nation's best clocking for that division at 5:16.9, but Monaco's time is better than the listed national record for a 10-year-old.

Dave Bingley placed fifth to aid Monaco as the Strider's winning team time was 29:46.6.

The Striders only finished fifth in the team standings in the 14-15 group, but Kingery ran a 10:07.0 for the individual honors and teammate Kelly Lawson was second in the nation at 10:15.0.

The Striders were fourth in the 9-under division, led by clocking of 6:07.0 for the mile.
