

Carlmont, Templeman Dominate CC Opener

Hans Templeman and Carlmont High are up to their old cross country tricks again this year.

Carlmont won all four divisions in a cross country season's opener at San Carlos Monday afternoon and Templeman set a new course record while winning the varsity race.

On San Carlos' three-mile course, Templeman sauntered around in 16:17 to top the old

course mark of 16:18.5 set last year by the Dons' Randy Lawson.

Templeman, a senior, was the SPAL's cross country athlete of the year last season.

Carlmont's team time (best five runners' times totaled) of 84:81 broke the course record by three seconds.

Carlmont topped the field with 22 points (low score wins), followed by San Carlos (59), Sequoia (71), Menlo-

Atherton (101) and Pioneer of San Jose (105).

San Carlos' Brad Gieser set a new freshman record on the short (2.2 mile) course, covering the distance in 13:16, surpassing the old frosh mark of 13:37 set last year by San Carlan Matt Yeo, who this year finished third in the varsity race.

Roark Mulligan and Carl Cattarin, both of Carlmont, won the junior varsity and sophomore races, respectively.

M-A Harriers Disappoint Yanicks

"We didn't do too good," are Coach Plato Yanicks comments on Menlo-Athertons poor showing in its first cross-country meet of the year at San Carlos last Monday.

The M-A harriers ran against San Carlos, Carlmont, Sequoia, St. Francis, and Pioneer on the Don's hilly three mile course.

Junior John Barbour paced the Bear runners with an eleventh place finish followed by Doug Yost in the 13th position.

Yanicks expressed the feeling that his squad will have improved by next Monday's meet with Oceana, Serra, and Lowell on M-A's route.
