

Crowley captures SPAL varsity race

BELMONT — Gunn High senior Steve Crowley, a second-place finisher last year, won the South Peninsula Athletic League cross-country championship Thursday in record time.

Crowley covered the hilly, three-mile Crystal Springs course in 14:44 to edge Carlmont's Carl Cattarin, who checked in with a 14:46 clocking. Cattarin held the former record of 15:03.

In the team standings, San Carlos won

with a low score of 41 points, followed by defending champion Carlmont 47, Gunn 78, Woodside 115, Menlo-Atherton 141, Cubberley 154, Sequoia 156 and Palo Alto 163.

Gordon MacMitchell, expected to be one of the top placers in the race, didn't compete. MacMitchell, a standout for Palo Alto in previous meets, has transferred back to Gunn, according to Paly coach Forrest Jamieson.

San Carlos also won the junior varsity event while Carlmont took the sophomore and freshman titles.
