TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

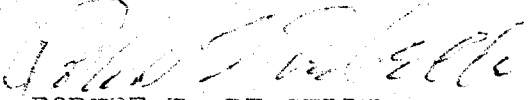
Enclosed is the results for the first 55 finishers in the recently held (12-21-74) National AAU Junior Cross Country Championship.

The weather was cold, but windless. Temperature being around 53°.

The course was flat, packed sand, laced with four barriers to emulate the World Cross Country Championships (or European style of Cross Country).

We are listing this first fifty five runners only for the benefit of the magazines and press. Checks are being made of all Registration Committees that those entered did so with legal AAU Registrations. We will delete from the list any persons entered improperly.

This was a selection site for the World Games to be held at Rabat, Morocco, 16 March 1975, for the Juniors. The top four are guaranteed a trip, if in good condition on the first of March. There is a possibility of funds for an additional two men to fill out the team.
