

Serra retains ^{REGION I} x-country title

Serra High easily repeated as champion, the Padres' Stan Ross moved up to claim the individual title and St. Francis also qualified for the Central Coast Section cross country finals during Thursday's Region I finals at Crystal Springs.

Ross, a senior, moved up from fourth last year to win by 15 seconds in 15:13 over Aragon's Joe Green. Serra, which also got strong efforts by Tom Jacobs, Mike Rinaldi and John Collopy, out-pointed Aragon, 48-99.

St. Francis scored 107 for fourth, led

by Redwood City's Dave Cortez, who placed fifth in 15:42. Jim Rochford, Kurt Rochlitz, Kevin O'Halloran and Mark Sullivan also aided the Lancers.

The top four teams qualified for the finals.

Half Moon Bay raced to the frosh-soph title with 46 points to Hillsdale's 101.

St. Francis's Jim Kaspari also qualified for CCS by finishing sixth.

The CCS meet is scheduled Tuesday at 3 p.m. at Coyote Park in San Jose.
