HMB gals eye top title

Half Moon Bay High's undefeated girls, the newly crowned Central Coast Section cross country champions, go after a new ultimate in the prep running world tomorrow.

The Cougars will compete for the official Northern California championship in the first running of the NorCal Invitational at the Crystal Springs course in Belmont.

The race for the girls begins at noon, followed by the race for the boys at 12:30.

All told, 12 teams and 36 individuals will run in each race, a field of 120 in each (teams include seven runners).

The top three teams and nine individuals from the CCS, North Coast and Sac-Joaquin sections will run, as will the championship teams and top three individuals from the Northern Section, San Francisco Section and Oakland Section (the eight-school San Francisco and six-school Oakland leagues are sections in themselves).

Yanicks noted that strategy for the girls will be a bit different, since the California Interscholastic Federation would sanction only a two-mile female race. In the CCS, the girls run three miles, the same distance as the boys.

"That makes picking the girls race especially difficult because speed becomes more of a factor," said Yanicks. Rio Americano of Sacramento may be the top challenger for Half Moon Bay, along with Homestead of the CCS. HMB survived Homestead's challenge by only 85-87 (low score wins) in the CCS finals Tuesday. Other CCS entry is Soquel.

Locally, the individual entries are Carlmont junior Kevin O'Connor (seventh in the CCS) and Carlmont sophomore Paula Foianini (ninth in the CCS). Half Moon Bay's aces are Penny Goldthorpe (fourth in the CCS) and Becky Schmidt (12th), with depth provided by Audrey Betten-court, Stacy Siegman and Debbie McGregor.

Cougar Kittens Win C.C.S. Championship
