FRANK DUARTE

UCI HEAD COACH

Frank Duarte assumes the head coaching position this year, bringing not only a local, but also a national and an international flavor to UCI. Duarte, a local product, attended Huntington Beach High School, Orange Coast College, and graduated from Cal State Long Beach in 1964.

At all three schools he ran both track and cross country, while also acting as captain for the cross country teams at each institution. At Long Beach State, Duarte was the cross country conference champion. In 1963, Frank was an alternate on the Mexican Pan American team.

As a coach Duarte has led the Orange County Blue Angels, an AAU club, for the past several seasons. During his tenure many national champions have participated on his 8-18 year old team. Several boys and girls age-group world records have been set.

1980 WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY OUTLOOK

Entering only their third season of intercollegiate competition, UC Irvine's women's cross country team continues to build-up its ranks. The 1980 Anteaters are a youthful group with only one senior and three juniors on the pre-season roster.

"Any one of five or six girls is capable of earning the number one spot on this year's team," says first-year head coach Frank Duarte. "The talent and ability is pretty much even."

Monique Gregoire and Nancy Schwarz are among the top runners competing for the number one spot.

Gregoire, this season's lone senior, is in her second year at UCI after transferring from Mount San Antonio College. She has good times in the 800 meters (2:21.4) and the 1500 meters (4:52.1). Her best time for 5,000 meters is 20:35.

Schwarz, a freshman from South Pasadena High School, is a durable runner with a best time of 11:30 for two miles.

Ginny Lee, a sophomore from Mater Dei High School, returns with a best time of 11:28.1 for 3,000 meters. Also back is Kathy Trainor, a junior from Huntington Beach, with a best time of 21:56 for 5,000 meters.

"Our veterans will help us at the top of the order, but we'll be depending on our freshmen to pick-up the slack in the four, five, and six spots," says Duarte. "We hope to gradually improve throughout the season and build for the conference championships at San Luis Obispo."
