Pt. Pinole Regional Park, November 12--On a very rainy day, senior Martin Higginbotham (Berkeley), the Richmond-Berkeley Athletic League Champion who placed 6th last year, upset Scott Hill (Mission San Jose, Fremont), the Mission Valley Athletic League champion who was fifth last year, by three seconds-14:54 to 14:57. The runners were covered by mud from head to toe. Senior Jim Howard (Northgate, Walnut Creek), the Diablo Valley Athletic League champion who was tenth last year, placed third in 15:16.

Three boys' teams-Livermore (3rd in 1982), Berkeley (1st in 1982), and San Ramon (4th in 1982)--tied for first with 94 points. The title went to Livermore, whose sixth runner placed 42nd. Berkeley's sixth man was 51st and San Ramon's was 55th. Junior Tina Goodykoontz (San Ramon), the East Bay Athletic League champion and fifth here last year, defeated junior Julie Rivers (Livermore), third in the EBAL by 15 seconds. Tom Cathcart of Dublin noticed that Rivers had wandered off the course and called her back. Tom's daughter Amy of Amador Valley, the defending champion, placed third in 18:27.

San Ramon (Danville), who was second last year, easily won the girls' title with 33 points. They had four finishers in the top six. Amador Valley (Pleasanton), 3rd in 1982, was second with 94 points followed by College Park (Pleasant Hill) with 97.
